## Dry weather is good news for milo

August, and yields may suffer because of the heat this year. What the dry weather will do, Olson said, is speed up harvest since the corn is drying faster than usual.

Some dryland corn fields west of Colby have already been cut. Those fields, Olson said, have about 14-15 percent moisture. Still, he predicted, the corn crop may not be as good as last year.

Corn is typically harvested earlier than milo be-

cause milo needs a killing freeze, the agronomist said. The freeze can harm the crop if it comes to early, or if the milo hasn't matured enough.

Olson said county farmers have been planting fewer milo acres in favor of more corn and soy beans. Agriculture Department statistics show farmers in northwest Kansas planted 240,000 acres of milo last year and averaged about 79 bushels per acre. Farmers planted about 2.7 million acres across Kansas. Figures for this season were not yet available.

Scott Staggenborg, an agronomist and crop researcher at K-State, says Kansas is the leading producer of grain sorghum in the U.S. In 2008, farmers and ranchers in the state produced 45.4 percent (214,500,000 bushels) of the nation's crop and in 2009, 58.6 percent (224,400,000 bushels). "Grain sorghum is, however,

more than a cash crop for Kansas," said Staggenborg, who credited both statistics to "Kansas Farm Facts," a U.S. Department of Agriculture publication.




