Regents want \$50 million

Regents' spokesman Kip Peterson said Kansas ranks 36th in the nation and last in the Big 12 in per capita state need-based financial aid per student. Meanwhile, student debt continues to increase. In 2008, 62 percent of graduates from public universities had student loans, and the average student debt was \$20,200, which is 20 percent higher than in 2004.

Under the program, scholarships would be available to in-state students from families making less than the statewide median income of \$50,174 annually. These loans could be forgiven for graduates who chose to work in Kansas.

Regent Janie Perkins of Garden City said she believed the proposal would help.

"There are a lot of students out there who without this help are not going to be able" to attend college, she said.

programs, including expansion of engineering graduates from Kansas, Wichita State and Kansas State. Washburn also would create a doctorate in nursing, and Kansas would add slots for nursing students.

Community colleges would get one-third of the money to help with work force development. Participating colleges and universities would be required to find a 2-for-1 match of \$7 million.

One highlight of the budget plan is a proposal that would allow the state's universities to keep state sales tax generated on their campuses for a \$10 million scholarship fund for low- and middle-income students.

The program would be funded with \$6 million in state sales taxes on purchases made on campuses, plus \$4 million provided by the universities.

anyone who wants to get rid of a 200-pound television will have to pay \$50.

She said the 25 cents covers only part of the expenses, with nothing coming back for operating costs. To pay for all expenses, including labor, the building, supplies and the like, the cost would amount to 65 cents a pound, so recyclers are still getting a bargain.

"With all the mercury and other goodies in a television and other electronic gadgets such as computers, or anything with a circuit board, those items aren't actu-

ally safe to end up in the landfill," Koon added.

She said that since March 2009, the center has recycled 2.8 tons of equipment that still had some life to it back into the community. Computers have been refurbished, and microwaves were repaired, among other things, and were sold through the recycle store located on South Country Club.

Koon said she thought the state should have given them more time, because it takes a while to get a program like this figured out. By the time things begin to run

smoothly, the grant period is over. She added that Colby has been recycling for about 15 years, and each year the volume has gone up.

"The Northwest Regional Recycling group is the farthest advanced for a self sustaining recycling program over the other seven groups in Kansas," she said.

Koon said that with only three Wednesdays left in the free program, she encourages people to bring their items to the center as soon as they can.

electronic waste is expensive," Koon said, "as evidenced by the costs that have been chalked up since the free e-waste recycling program began."

Koon, the regional recycling director for eight northwest Kansas counties, said the center has recycled 168.3 tons of electronic waste since the program began Sept. 28, 2008, at a total cost of \$73,389. That included \$6,755 for shipping costs and \$66,633 for recycling.

She said that the grant provided by the Kansas Department of Health and Environment is coming to a close in only three weeks,

Western Kansas district decides to close school

RANSOM (AP) - Despite pleas from parents, a western Kansas school district has decided to close one of its elementary schools and move all students into the high school.

The Western Plains district, which includes Bazine and Ransom, will close the elementary school in Ransom at the end of the school year. The elementary school in Bazine will stay open.

The *Hays Daily News* reports

that the board voted unanimously Monday to close the school, although some patrons asked members to put the issue to a public vote in the spring.

Board member Denice Flax says she was told by the Kansas Association of School Boards that state law does not allow a public vote on school closings.

School officials said closing the school will save the district \$95,000 a year.
