statements or question him. The only other joint appearance planned before the general election is Oct. 21 in Salina.

The Democrat noted that Huelskamp didn't vote for state transportation programs in 1999 and this year, received a zero rating from the Kansas Association of School Boards and was kicked off the state Senate's budget-writing Ways and Means Committee in 2003 in a dispute with less conservative GOP leaders.

"At some point in time - and I think it's quite a while ago for him - you cross the line from conservative into extreme and radical," Jilka said in his closing statement.

After the debate, Huelskamp dismissed such comments as "name-calling" and said they were an attempt to distract voters from Jilka's support for the new health care law and his positions on immigration. He predicted voters would repudiate Obama and his fellow Democrats in the Nov. 2 election.

"If you like what's happening in Washington now, you will like my

opponent," Huelskamp said in his opening debate statement.

Huelskamp and Jilka are seeking the seat held by Republican Rep. Jerry Moran, who's running for the U.S. Senate. A Libertarian candidate, Jack Warner, of Wright, also is on the ballot but didn't participate in Monday night's forum because of a scheduling conflict.

Like other GOP candidates across the nation, Huelskamp has made the new health care law a major issue. Huelskamp wants to repeal it, arguing it amounts to a huge new federal entitlement that hurts the economy.

"The last thing we need to do is empower bureaucrats and politicians to control our health care decisions," Huelskamp said. "They already run a Medicaid system. It's not working. They run a Medicare system. It's not working."

Jilka said repealing the law would prevent young adults from staying on their parents' health insurance and allow people to be denied coverage over pre-existing medical conditions. He also noted that the Congressional Budget Office projected it would reduce the federal budget deficit over time.

**Kansans head to Russia to boost cattle industry**

TOPEKA (AP) - Two Kansas ranchers and an official from the state Commerce Department are heading to Russia to help promote U.S. cattle.

The Kansans are joining representatives of Colorado and Montana on a trade mission that begins Saturday and ends Oct. 12.

The Kansas Department of

Commerce is sending agriculture specialist J.J. Jones. Traveling with him are ranchers Mark Rohr, of Hays, and Daniel Mushrush, of Strong City.

The group will meet with beef producers and tour farms in Russia and discuss U.S. cattle genetics. They also expect to attend a livestock exhibition.
