

Gatlin said he and Umberger are the only ones in the department with instructor/coordinator certification. He said the proposed changes would allow him to handle the bookkeeping, billing, payroll, personnel and scheduling responsibilities.

He said by dividing up Rinehart's duties, he believes what had been a three-person team could be done by two people working closely to help each other.

He proposed a pay increase of \$4 to \$5 an hour for himself and Umberger with the added duties.

"Advanced" training level. Emergency medical technicians with a "B" designation must take a course to move to the advanced level or do further study to become an emergency responder. All certified first responders must take a transition course to become an emergency responder, he said. The transitions can run from 16 to 120 class hours, he said.

hovered each year under a billion bushels, statistics show. Last year, it was 1.4 billion bushels and it is estimated to reach 1.3 billion bushels this year. Kansas is expected to harvest its second largest corn crop on record in 2010.

Corn harvest in the fall – when other row crops mature – puts an added strain on the old elevators original built to handle the winter wheat harvest in June, when storage space is more readily available. The storage shortage is further aggravated by the fact that

than winter wheat. A good acre of wheat produces between 40 and 50 bushels per acre. That compares to the new high tech corn varieties that average yields of more than 225 bushels per acre.

"I don't know if you need a lot of economic analysis to figure out our growers are harvesting more bushels of about the same number of acres," said Sue Schulte, spokeswoman for the Kansas Corn Association. "We have needed more storage especially for the weather. Over time, I am sure we fall crops for several years, and if factors like low interest rates are busting at the seams as we are in corn yields more bushels per acre helping to get that done, that's some locations right now."
