Colby leading in energy challenge

Wilks, Colby High School; Lane Patterson, regional coordinator; Rick Dickman, city building inspector; Lon Frahm, Colby Rotary Club; Kevin Bottrell, editor of the *Colby Free Press*; Paul and Sharon Steele, Thomas County commissioners; Gary Stewart, Fairview Estates; Jarrod Spencer, Thomas County Ministerial Alliance; Leilani Thomas, Colby Convention and Visitors Bureau; Al Gerstner; and Terrel Harrison, superintendent of Colby Public Schools.

Armstrong said the winner will get \$100,000 for an LED (light emitting diode) lighting project or an energy conservation project. She said the city could use the money to put in solar panels or buy a wind generator.

The first part of the contest measures the energy saved by switching from regular incandescent light bulbs to compact fluorescent light bulbs, Armstrong said. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency says replacing all the regular bulbs in the country with fluorescent light bulbs should save enough energy to light more than 2.5 million homes a year.

According to the Take Charge website, the competition is based

on switches per capita. After someone makes the jump to compact fluorescents, they enter their numbers into the website takechargeks.org and the bulbs are counted along with others in town. Because competition is based on population, it's possible for a town to have switched more bulbs than a smaller town, but still be losing within their region.

Colby people have saved \$3,756 by switching 556 bulbs so far, the website shows. WaKeeney is in a distant second place with 18 switches and \$126 saved. In order to be able to report a switch for Colby, you have to be at least 18 and have a 67701 zip code, Armstrong said.

The next segment of the contest involves citizens getting household energy audits and then making improvements based on the auditor's recommendations. Efficiency Kansas, a state agency that has a low-cost loan program for energy-efficiency improvements, and Midwest Energy both conduct household audits.

Armstrong said Efficiency Kansas' financial aid comes in the form of a loan and Midwest Energy will add loan payments into a homeowner's utility bill.

Driver shot in chase Sunday

Kevin Butts, and the ambulance was later sent to pick up the injured driver.

The Toyota lost a tire a couple of miles east of where it hit the stop sticks and the speed was down to about 40 mph, Trooper Frey reported.

He said the Toyota was "all over the place" and the woman was waving the gun out the window.

A highway patrol dispatcher reported that the Colorado State Patrol had not had and contact with the Toyota, but the owner had reported his Colorado license plates stolen while on a Scenic Byway in that state.

Trooper Frey reported that the Toyota was slowing down as the chase approached the Thomas County line where Trooper Kummer was waiting. The Toyota pulled off I-70 at the Brewster exit and drove north toward Brewster.

The state dispatcher told the troopers with the slower speeds, the use of "intervention tactics" had been authorized.

The Toyota continued north past Brewster on Thomas County Road 2 with three troopers, three Sherman County patrol cars, and at least one Thomas County sheriff's vehicle following.

The state dispatcher told the troopers the use of deadly fire had been authorized if needed.

A minute later, Frey said he had fired shots at the Toyota and the car had stopped about two miles north of Brewster.

Shortly, the troopers reported having the woman in custody and shortly after they had the driver as well.

The Goodland ambulance was brought to the scene to treat and transport the man, who had been shot in the upper left back. Thomas County dispatched a Colby ambulance as well.

When the dust cleared, the Goodland ambulance took the man to Goodland Regional Medical Center and a deputy followed the ambulance to the hospital.

Sherman County Undersheriff Roger Studer, who had picked up the chase at the Goodland exit, took the women to the Sherman County Bastille.

The chase lasted about 20 minutes and covered about 30 miles across Sherman County into Thomas County.

Patrol Lt. Kevin Winston was called to the scene and directed the handling of the evidence and vehicles. He had the Kansas Bureau of Investigation called to investigate the shooting.

Trooper Frey's car, with bullet holes, was escorted back to Goodland and secured at the sheriff's office.

Sheriff Butts said the woman's fingerprints had been sent in and prints taken on the man. He said the driver had been flown to a Denver hospital after treatment in Goodland.

Because of the Martin Luther King Day holiday, no one at the KBI was available for comment today.
