Goodland police department investigates gun club suicide

Ambulance and Goodland police were called to the Goodland Gun Club about 9 a.m. on Wednesday with report of a man on the ground with an apparent gun shot to the chest, and Dr. Travis Daise, assistant coroner, was called to the scene of what was determined to be a suicide.

Goodland city employee, Neil Thornburg, was out checking water wells Wednesday morning when he saw a white van at the Goodland Gun Club north of Renner Field and found a man lying on the ground next to the van. He called 911 and an ambulance was sent and the police called.

Police Sergeant Greg Kroskey said the call came in about 9:05 a.m., and Officer Doug Whitson and the ambulance arrived on the scene shortly after.

Whitson said Dr. Daise was called to pronounce Brian Black, 39, dead at the scene.

Whitson said apparently Black had dropped his two children off at school before 8:30 a.m., and drove out to the gun club, where he was a member, and sat down on the ground and shot himself in the chest from a 12 gauge over and under shotgun.

Black of 802 Harrison, had been a mechanic at Finley Motor for about 11 years. Whitson said his wife Tamera found a note at their home saying goodbye and he was sorry.

Whitson said he was told Black had been depressed and his wife said he had been suffering from severe migraine headaches.

Sgt. Kroskey said the suicide must have happened shortly after 8:30 a.m. because a sheriff's deputy drove by the gun club about 8:30 a.m. and there was no van parked near the club house at that time.
