AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION TAX INCREMENT FINANCING BONDS, SERIES 2011-1, OF THE CITY OF COLBY, KANSAS; PROVIDING FOR THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF AN ANNUAL TAX FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING THE PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON SAID BONDS AS THEY BECOME DUE; AUTHORIZING CERTAIN OTHER DOCUMENTS AND ACTIONS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH; AND MAKING CERTAIN COVENANTS WITH RESPECT

WHEREAS, the City of Colby, Kansas (the "City") is a city of the second class, duly created, organized and existing under the Constitution and laws of the State; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to promote, stimulate and develop the general and economic welfare of the City and the state of Kansas (the "State") and to assist in the development and redevelopment of eligible areas within the City, thereby promoting the general welfare of the citizens of the State and the City, by acquiring property and providing for the development and relating thereto; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 12-1770 et seq., as amended (the "Act"), the City is authorized to establish redevelopment districts within eligible areas of the City, as said terms are defined in the Act, to approve redevelopment district plans for the completion of redevelopment projects within such redevelopment project areas, and to finance all or a portion of redevelopment project costs from tax increment revenues and various fees collected within such redevelopment revenues derived redevelopment projects, revenues derived from local sales taxes, other revenues described in the Act, or a combination thereof or from the proceeds of full faith and credit tax increment bonds of the City or special obligation tax increment bonds of the City payable from such described

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Act and Ordinance No. 1453 passed on November 18, 2008, the governing body of the City has created a redevelopment district within the City, the boundaries of which were expanded by Ordinance No. 1456 passed on July 20, 2010 (said redevelopment district, as expanded, herein referred to as the "Redevelopment District"); and

WHEREAS, upon the creation of a redevelopment district pursuant to the Act, the City may propose to undertake one or more redevelopment projects and shall prepare a redevelopment project plan, which may be implemented in separate development stages, in consultation with the City's planning commission; and

WHEREAS, in consultation with the City's planning commission, the City prepared a proposed redevelopment project plan for development of the Redevelopment District, and a public hearing on such proposed redevelopment project plan was held on September 21, 2010, after duly published, delivered and mailed notice in accordance with the provisions of the Act; and

WHEREAS, following the conclusion of such public hearing, the governing body passed Ordinance No. 1482 approving the proposed redevelopment project plan (the 'Project Plan"); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLBY, KANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Definitions of Words and Terms. In addition to words and terms defined elsewhere herein, the following words and terms in this Ordinance shall have the meanings hereinafter set forth. Unless the context shall otherwise indicate words importing the singular number shall include the plural and vice versa, and words importing persons shall include firms, public bodies, as well as natural persons.

"Act" means the Constitution and statutes of the State including K.S.A. 10-101 to 10-125, inclusive, K.S.A. 10-620 et seq., and K.S.A. 12-1770 et seq., all as amended and supplemented from time to

"Aquatic Center Sales Tax" means the Citv's retail sales and compensating use taxes for aquatic center projects, currently in the amount of 0.75%.

"Bond and Interest Fund" means the Bond and Interest Fund of the City for its general obligation bonds.

"Bond Resolution" means the resolution to be adopted by the governing body of the City prescribing the terms and details of the Bonds and making covenants with respect

"Bonds" means the City's General Obligation Tax Increment Financing Bonds, Series 2011-1, dated May 1, 2011, authorized by this Ordinance.

"City" means the City of Colby, Kansas.

'City Sales Taxes" means collectively: (a) the Aquatic Center Sales Tax; and (b) the Economic Development Sales Tax.

"City Sales Tax Revenues" means collectively the gross receipts of the City under K.S.A. 12-187 et seq., as amended, and K.S.A. 12-198, as amended, during the Tax Collection Period, from the City Sales Taxes and any successor taxes thereto, with respect to retail sales within the Redevelopment District.

"Clerk" means the duly appointed and acting Clerk of the City or, in the Clerk's absence, the duly appointed Deputy Clerk or Acting Clerk.

"County Sales Tax Revenues" means the City's share under K.S.A. 12-187 et seg., as amended, and K.S.A. 12-198, as amended (currently 0.4851%), during the Tax Collection Period, of the retail sales and compensating use taxes of Thomas County, Kansas (currently 1.00%) and any successor taxes thereto, with respect to retail sales within the Redevelopment

"Economic Development Sales Tax" means the City's retail sales and compensating use taxes economic development purposes, currently in the amount of 0.25%.

"Incremental Tax Revenues" means collectively: (a) the Property Tax Revenues; and (b) the Sales Tax Revenues. "Mayor" means the duly elected and

acting Mayor or, in the Mayor's absence, the duly appointed and/or elected Vice Mayor or Acting Mayor of the City. "Ordinance" means this Ordinance

"Revenues" means: (a) the Incremental Tax Revenues; and (b) the Supplemental

"Sales Tax Revenues" collectively: (a) the City Sales Tax Revenues; and (b) the County Sales Tax Revenues.

"State" means the State of Kansas. "Supplemental Revenues" means

during the Tax Collection Period and in accordance with the Act, such other revenues of the Issuer (other than the Sales Tax Revenues and Property Tax Revenues) derived from or held in connection with the undertaking and carrying out of the Redevelopment Project.

"Tax Collection Period" means: (a) with respect to Property Tax Revenues, the period commencing with the first payment of taxes levied following the date of the establishment of the Redevelopment District and continuing until the later of the date no Bonds remain Outstanding or the Redevelopment Project is complete, but no later than the payment of taxes levied 20 years from the date of the approval of the Redevelopment Plan; (b) with respect to the City Sales Tax Revenues, the period commencing with the approval of the Redevelopment Plan and continuing until the later of the date no Bonds remain Outstanding, the Redevelopment Project is complete, or: (i) April 1, 2020, with respect to the Aquatic Center Sales Tax, and (ii) April 1, 2012, with respect to the Economic Development Sales Tax; (c) with respect to the County Sales Tax Revenues, the period commencing with the approval of the Redevelopment Plan and continuing until the later of the date no Bonds remain Outstanding or the Redevelopment Project is complete, but not to exceed 20 years from the date of the approval of the Redevelopment Plan; and (d) with respect to the Supplemental Revenues, the period commencing with the approval of the Redevelopment Plan and continuing until the later of the date no Bonds remain Outstanding or the Redevelopment Project is complete, but not to exceed 20 vears from the date of the approval of the Redevelopment Plan

Section 2. Authorization of the Bonds. There shall be issued and hereby are authorized and directed to be issued the General Obligation Tax Increment Financing Bonds, Series 2011-1, of the City in the principal amount of \$1,130,000, for the purpose of providing funds to: (a) pay Redevelopment Project Costs; and (b) pay costs of issuance of the Bonds.

#### **Public Notice** Section 3. Security for the Bonds.

The Bonds shall be general obligations of the City payable from, and secured as to the payment of principal and interest by a pledge of, the Revenues, and the City hereby pledges the Revenues to the payment of the principal of and interest on the Bonds. If said Revenues are not sufficient to provide for the payment of the principal of and interest on the Bonds, the City shall levy taxes as set forth in Section 5 hereof. The full faith, credit and resources of the City are hereby irrevocably pledged for the prompt payment of the principal of and interest on the Bonds as the same become due.

The Mayor, Clerk and other City officials are hereby further authorized and directed to execute any and all documents and take such actions as they may deem necessary or advisable in order to carry out and perform the purposes of the Ordinance, and to make alterations, changes or additions in the foregoing agreements, statements, instruments and other documents herein approved, authorized and confirmed which they may approve, and the execution or taking of such action shall be conclusive

Section 7. Governing Law. This Ordinance and the Bonds shall be governed exclusively by and construed in accordance with the applicable laws of the State.
