# Track team wins at home

The Colby High School girls track team won its home meet by a huge margin last Friday.

The team won the Colby Invitational with 152 points. Holcomb, who came in second, had 84.

Emilea Finley once again placed first in the 1,600 meters and 800 meters. She also placed second in the pole vault with a vault of 8 feet.

Katrina Kaus placed first in the 3,200 meters and second in the 1,600 meters, 24.2 second behind Finley. Kaitlyn Flanagan placed first in the 100 meters with 13.4 and third in the 300-meter hurdles with 49.84. Brenna McKee placed 1st in the 400 meters with 1:03.8 and first in the long jump with 16 feet, 2.75 inches.

The girls 4-by-100 relay team of Flanagan, McKee, Julia Hutfless and Kayla Hockersmith placed first with 52 seconds. The 4-by-400 team of Kaus, Finley, McKee and Morgan Bell also placed first with 4:13.4.

Other individual results include:

Hockersmith, fourth in the 100 meters with 13.73, second in the 200 meters with 27.89.

Hutflés, sixth in the 100 meters with 14.01, fifth in the 200 meters with 29.28.

Morgan Bell, third in the high jump with 5 feet, second in the 300-meter hurdles with 49.84.

Lauren Bell, fifth in the high jump with 4 feet, 8 inches.

Kortney Bredemeier, sixth in the triple jump with 28 feet, 11.5 inches.

Shelby Gardner, second in the shot put with 33 feet, 3.5 inches.

The Colby boys team improved their standings over previous meets, coming in second out of 14 teams. The boys were just eight team points behind Holcomb and 24 points ahead of Goodland.

Kale Arnberger placed first in the 400 meters with 51.82. Arnberger got another first place along with teammates Troy Koon, Wiatt Binder and Beau Brown when their 4-by-100 relay team finished on top with 44.87.

Other individual boys results include:

Koon, sixth in the 100 meters with 11.86.
