ack of such, I am requesting a suggestion fo deep- cleaning or sanitizing my SPA TUB. I've just cleaned it and scrubbed the jets with an old toothbrush. I want to be certain that all bacteria is gone so I can feel good about getting in my spa
tub, which came with the house I bought. - Heidi Gold, via email
Heidi, you are not alone in wanting to know
how to clean a spa tub when moving into a house,
condo or apartment.
Make sure you have good ventilation and no
kids or pets around. You will need househol chlorine bleach and powdered (or gel) DISH WASHER detergent for this project. Fill the tub with hot water so that the jets are covered at least several inches. Add 1 to 2 cups of household
chlorine bleach and $1 / 4$ to $1 / 2$ cup of dishwasher chlorine bleach and $1 / 4$ to $1 / 2$ cup of dishwasher ing on the size of the spa tub, you may use more dishwasher detergent.
Run the spa for at least 20 minutes, turn off and let the water sit for 30 minutes, then drain. Refill with cold water and run the jets for 10 minutes, then drain the water when finished. - Heloise P.S... If you use bath additives, you may want to SEND A GREAT HINT TO:

1. Two notrump. Partner's one-notrump re sponse shows six to 10 high-card points. As there is no way of knowing whether he is closer to the
upper or lower end of this range, the best you can do is to invite him to bid again by raising to two notrump. Partner should pass waximum.
 points. With less than 16 you'd pass one notrump 26 points. With 19 or more you'd raise to three notrump because the combined hands have no less than 25 points.

the best contract. If you were to rebid two spades over one notrump, you'd run the risk of finding partner with a singleton spade and perhaps four
or five clubs or five clubs. 3. Three hearts. You should assume there's a
game somewhere and therefore jump-shift to three hearts (forcing). It would be extremely pes-
simistic to bid only two hearts over one notrump since partner might pass. That's what you'd bid if you had only 12 or 13 high-card points instead you can make a game, but the odds favor strong

not overly optimistic of you to expect partner to provide at least one more. You should therefore bid game without further ado. It would be wrong
to bid only three spades, which would run the risk of partner passing when game is a near-certainty of partner passing when game is a near-certainty.
2. Three spades. With only seven sure winners, this hand is obviously not as strong as the previpartner to bid again.
If partner has minimum values for his notrump response, he'll pass -- and you may have trouble making even nine tricks. But if partner has maximum values, he will bid again, and you'll probably wind up making forn or five spales. With partner and abide by his decision.
