

Clean spa tub in your home Dear Heloise: Due to your experience and my lack of such, I am requesting a suggestion for deep- cleaning or sanitizing my SPA TUB. I've just cleaned it and scrubbed the jets with an old toothbrush. I want to be certain that all bacteria is gone so I can feel good about getting in my spa

Heidi, you are not alone in wanting to know how to clean a spa tub when moving into a house,

Make sure you have good ventilation and no kids or pets around. You will need household chlorine bleach and powdered (or gel) DISH-WASHER detergent for this project. Fill the tub with hot water so that the jets are covered at least several inches. Add 1 to 2 cups of household chlorine bleach and 1/4 to 1/2 cup of dishwasher detergent. There is no exact "recipe," so depending on the size of the spa tub, you may use more

Run the spa for at least 20 minutes, turn off and let the water sit for 30 minutes, then drain. Refill with cold water and run the jets for 10 minutes, then drain the water when finished. - Heloise

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


Difficulty Level ★★★★



Spade. Partner responds One Notrump. What would you bid now with each of the following five hands?

1. ♠ KQ743 ♥ KQ6 ♦ AJ3 ♣ K9

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Bidding Quiz

1. Two notrump. Partner's one-notrump r sponse shows six to 10 high-card points. As the is no way of knowing whether he is closer to the upper or lower end of this range, the best you ca do is to invite him to bid again by raising to tw notrump. Partner should pass with a minimum and continue bidding with a maximum.

The two-notrump bid logically shows 16 to points. With less than 16 you'd pass one notrum because the combined hands could not contain 26 points. With 19 or more you'd raise to three notrump because the combined hands have r less than 25 points.

2. Two clubs. Despite your own strong pre erence for spades, you should bid two clubs. partner passes, indicating a distinct preference for clubs over spades and minimum values for his one-notrump response, you are probably the best contract. If you were to rebid two spade over one notrump, you'd run the risk of findir partner with a singleton spade and perhaps for or five clubs.

3. Three hearts. You should assume there's game somewhere and therefore jump-shift three hearts (forcing). It would be extremely pe simistic to bid only two hearts over one notrum since partner might pass. That's what you'd b if you had only 12 or 13 high-card points instea of the actual 18. There's no absolute guarante you can make a game, but the odds favor stron action.

4. Four spades. Holding nine sure tricks, it not overly optimistic of you to expect partner provide at least one more. You should therefore bid game without further ado. It would be wron to bid only three spades, which would run the ris of partner passing when game is a near-certaint

5. Three spades. With only seven sure winner this hand is obviously not as strong as the prev ous one, so your best move is simply to invi partner to bid again.

If partner has minimum values for his notrum response, he'll pass -- and you may have troub making even nine tricks. But if partner has max mum values, he will bid again, and you'll prol ably wind up making four or five spades. With hands of intermediate strength, you must consu partner and abide by his decision.
