Economic Development Alliance Director Rick Patrick told Roberts he had experienced the EPA's clampdown on the steel industry in the 1970s. Businesses back then weren't given enough time to comply with new regulations, he said, and industry in many areas deteriorated.

Roberts said that businesses now spend an estimated 50.1 million hours dealing with permits and regulations. He agreed that a step-by-step process is needed to help comply with new regulations.
