# Juvenile Justice to move residents

Kansas Juvenile Justice Authority Commissioner Curtis Whitten announced last month that during September the authority will permanently relocate female youth residents currently housed at the Kansas Juvenile Correctional Complex in Topeka to a newer

stand-alone facility on the campus. There will continue to be absolutely no commingling of male and female youth residents. This move will provide better living conditions and better access to dining and medical services, and will create a safer and more

secure environment for the youth. There are fewer than 22 female youth and approximately 210 male youth housed at the complex. The authority also operates a smaller similar male facility at Larned which houses an average of 107 male youth.

# Student burglar can't explain

LARAMIE, Wyo. (AP) – An art student at the University of Wyoming has admitted to a bizarre string of car burglaries in which he stole everything from sleeping pills to a model airplane to a bow and some arrows. But the 22-year-old says he can't remember what he was thinking on the night he committed the crimes.
