AN ORDINANCE ADDING PENALTIES TO CHAPTER VIII, HEALTH AND WELFARE, ARTICLE 4. WEEDS, 08, OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF COLBY. KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLBY, COUNTY OF THOMAS, STATE OF KANSAS:

SECTION 1. The Code of the City of Colby, Kansas which is a codification of the general ordinances of the City of Colby was adopted, incorporated by reference, and approved by the City Council on June 19,

SECTION 2. That Chapter VIII, Health and Welfare, Article 4. Weeds, of the Municipal Code of the City of Colby, Kansas is hereby amended to add a new section, Section No. 8-408 Penalties, as follows:

ARTICLE 4. WEEDS

8-408 PENALTIES. Any person violating any of the provisions of this article shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined a minimum of \$100.00 for the first conviction, \$200.00 for the second conviction, and \$300.00 for third and subsequent violations in any eighteen (18) month period.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication in the official city
