**ORDINANCE NO. 1497**

**AN ORDINANCE ADDING PENALTIES TO CHAPTER VIII, HEALTH AND WELFARE, ARTICLE 4. WEEDS, SECTION 8-408, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF COLBY, KANSAS.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLBY, COUNTY OF THOMAS, STATE OF KANSAS:**

**SECTION 1.** The Code of the City of Colby, Kansas which is a codification of the general ordinances of the City of Colby was adopted, incorporated by reference, and approved by the City Council on June 19, 2007.

**SECTION 2.** That Chapter VIII, Health and Welfare, Article 4. Weeds, of the Municipal Code of the City of Colby, Kansas is hereby amended to add a new section, Section No. 8-408 Penalties, as follows:

**ARTICLE 4. WEEDS**

8-408 PENALTIES. Any person violating any of the provisions of this article shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined a minimum of \$100.00 for the first conviction, \$200.00 for the second conviction, and \$300.00 for third and subsequent violations in any eighteen (18) month period.

**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication in the official city newspaper.
