BAGGED ESSENTIALS


Dear Heloise: My husband and I frequently stay at condos when we travel so we can cook in. My hint is to prepare a large gallon zipper bag with essentials so I don't have to buy them once I arrive. When East did not play high-low to show a doubleton, West correctly concluded that his partner had the only missing diamond, which meant there could be no advantage to leading still another diamond. However, this left West with the problem of



would have made it impossible for South to score 10 tricks. If declarer won the club in his hand and led a trump to dummy's queen, he would have no safe way to return to his hand to draw trumps. Nor would he be any better off if he won the first club in dummy.


