## Sober drivers stay alive

This week Kansas roads will be busy with holiday there were 590 collisions, 153 injuries and six deaths. travelers. The Kansas Highway Patrol will mobilize, along with other law enforcement organizations across the state to participate in the annual Special Traffic Enforcement Program.

In addition to the campaign, Patrol officers will outfit their patrol cars with red ribbons to memorialize the lives lost due to impaired driving crashes around the holiday season. The Patrol will display the red ribbons throughout the Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Year's holidays.

The Patrol and other agencies will focus on impaired drivers, child passenger safety laws and seat belt use among travelers of all ages. There will be more law enforcement officers on streets and highways during the holiday period when travel increas-

Of these crashes, 44 were alcohol related, resulting in 30 injuries and four deaths.

The Patrol reminds motorists not to drink and drive, and do not let your friends or family members drive while impaired. If you consume alcohol, call for a sober ride home, or make plans to have a sober ride home before going to parties. Motorists concerned that another driver might be impaired can use their cell phone to dial \*47 (\*HP) on Kansas highways or \*582 (\*KTA) on the Kansas Turnpike to reach the nearest highway patrol dispatcher.

The Patrol encourages all motorists to tie a red ribbon to an antenna, side mirror, or door handle, pledging to drive safely, and not while impaired. If you are unable to get one from the Patrol, any 18-inch strip of red ribbon will show your support.


