Thomas County veterans invited to parade as marshals

Anyone who wants to enter the Thomas County Parade needs to register by 5 p.m. Friday, July 27, at the Colby/Thomas County Chamber of Commerce office.

The parade will be at 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, July 31. Participants will start at Franklin Avenue and Eighth Street and march or drive south on Franklin, then turn right on Cedar and go past Range Avenue to the Thomas County Fairgrounds.

At least 20 Thomas County veterans will act as grand marshals for the parade, riding on a float at the front, said Holly Whitaker, executive director for the Chamber.

"We sent out over 200 invitations to the veterans," she added. "We ask them to wear their uniform or hat; that way, we know what section of the service they were in."


