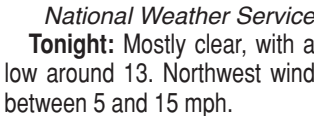


Former Catholic pastor here, Father Galen Long, is dead

TOPEKA (AP) — Attorney General Derek Schmidt says Kansas residents will share about \$50 million of a \$25 billion settlement reached between the federal government, states and several mortgage lenders.

Schmidt said the state's share of the settlement would be direct payments to some homeowners.

Under the agreement, Bank of America, JPMorgan Chase, Wells Fargo, Citigroup and Ally Financial will reduce loans for about 1 million households.
