Selden welcomed Midway Chiropractic as a new business at an open house on March 2 and 3.

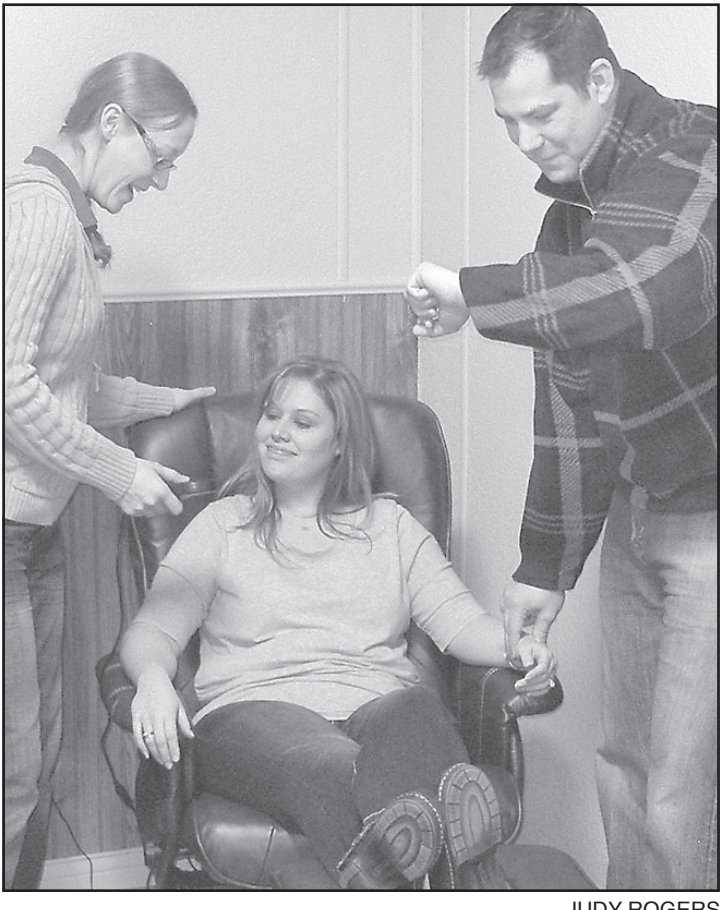
The business is at 105 S. Kansas in the former G&T Guns building.

# Farm news e-mails offered by agency

The Kansas Farm Service Agency now has an electronic news service.

"FSA is now offering free on-line communications through our GovDelivery electronic news service," said Adrian Polansky, executive director.

"News will now be sent via e-mail, allowing you to receive immediate notification of program news that is pertinent to your agricultural operation."

Through the GovDelivery electronic news service, anyone can establish subscriber preferences by choosing to receive federal farm program information by topic, by state and or by county. Subscribers can select as many options as they want, which allows producers who farm in multiple counties or across state lines to receive updates from each county in which they operate or have an interest.

Farm Service will automatically subscribe farmers and ranchers when they provide their e-mail address to the local office.

Those interested in receiving information through e-mail can subscribe to GovDelivery online at [www.fsa.usda.gov/subscribe](http://www.fsa.usda.gov/subscribe). After you enter your e-mail address, click on "+" next to "Updates for State and County." Scroll down and click on "+" next to "Kansas," select the counties which you have an interest and click on "Submit" at the bottom of the page. Note that there are other options available that provide national information by topic through e-mail.

"Unfortunately, the FSA budget deficit affects the way we normally do business," said Polansky. "We no longer have funding to mail newsletters and other mass mailings. GovDelivery is a free electronic news delivery service that ensures Kansas farmers and ranchers remain informed of program changes, signups and deadlines."

A small supply of printed newsletters will be available in the Farm Service county office for those that don't have e-mails.

# Conservation signup underway

The U.S. Department of Agriculture reminds landowners, farmers and ranchers that the opportunity to enroll in the Conservation Reserve Program general signup is here.

Producers who want to offer eligible land can enroll through Friday, April 6, at the Farm Service Agency service center.

Conservation Reserve is a voluntary program

that assists farmers, ranchers and other agricultural producers to protect their environmentally sensitive land. Producers enrolling plant long-term, resource-conserving covers in exchange for rental payments, cost-share and technical assistance.

# Sheep and goat conference planned for May

The Kansas State University Sheep and Goat Conference and trade show is slated for Friday through Sunday, May 4 to 6, in Manhattan, with a registration deadline of April 15.
