Weather Man leads chase through Colby

fired at the man, apparently missing, near the U.S. 83-U.S 40 junction.

The man drove north on U.S. 83 with at least four troopers close behind. Speeds ranged from 100 to 130 mph, slowing as the driver avoided traffic. Officers reported that the man appeared to be reaching under the seat or in the back seat, like he was trying to find a weapon.

Nine Mile junction of U.S. 83 and U.S. 24, but couldn't make it ahead of the fleeing suspect. The man turned west, driving toward Colby. He left it in the highway near the intersection with First Street Annex.

The chase roared on west into downtown. Witnesses said the


About a block west of the highway crossing, he left the tracks and tried to get back to a street. His car was boxed in by trees, and he abandoned it. Officers found him under a pickup. Troopers, deputies and city of-

Chief Alexander arrested the man and walked him up the block, accompanied by troopers, to a city police car. He was handcuffed and taken to the city-county Law Enforcement Center.

Shortly after noon, the driver still had not been identified. Officers said he wouldn't co-operate or give his name, so they were forced to take fingerprints and send them in for identification. In the initial search, no weapons were found, and there was no indication as to why he ran.
