"We also need to realize that crushing costs are heavily subsidized by the tipping fees," said Jumper. "Since we are accepting clean concrete at no charge, we should charge the county departments a little for using it to help cover some of those expenses."

Commissioners agreed that would be a good alternative, since they figured they could do two tons of crushed concrete in-house cheaper than one ton elsewhere.
