Patrol gives travel safety tips

This week, with roads busy with holiday travelers, the Kansas Highway Patrol will mobilize across the state to participate in the annual Special Traffic Enforcement Program.
 "With the Thanksgiving holiday weekend around the corner, the Kansas Highway Patrol and other local law enforcement officers will be out working Kansas roads to help ensure motorists get to their destinations safely," said Lt. Josh Kellerman. "Enjoy your holiday memories this Thanksgiving - designate a sober driver, and buckle up, every trip, every time."
 The patrol will focus on drunk or impaired drivers, child safety laws and seat belts.

During the 2011 Thanksgiving reporting period, there were 576 collisions, resulting in 140 injuries and one death. Of these wrecks, 26 were alcohol-related, resulting in 11 injuries.
 Before hitting the road, the Patrol encourages motorists to:
 • Make sure the vehicle is in good working order.
 • Stock the vehicle with items that would be beneficial if you were involved in a crash.
 • Plan your route and communicate this to your family.
 • Charge your cell phone, before you leave.
 • Dress for the weather.
