on display as a priceless collection of community history," said Taylor. "The collection documents the working community of 2012. (The original photo album) has been used in various ways over the years and today is the inspiration for our participation in 'The Way We Worked.'" In September and October, Colby photographers Michelle Morris and Laura Norris photographed over 120 businesses that chose to participate in the picture project. Included are Horlacher Jewelers, Farmers and Merchants Bank and the Colby Free Press, which were

all photographed in 1937 and again last fall. In addition to being photographed for the exhibit, the Free Press is also planning to include a special edition of photographs in the Friday, Feb. 15, paper to commemorate this project. The exhibit highlights many businesses that have changed their location, their name or their owner, as well as new businesses. Agricultural service-based companies, beauty shops and fuel stations are a few of the staples that have continued through time. But the photos of today also show how the world has changed over 75 years.

"We are so thankful for the many businesses and individuals who came together to make this exhibit possible," said Taylor. "We are especially appreciative of the Kansas Humanities Council for allowing us the opportunity to participate, research and document community stories of work as part of their 'Way We Worked' in Kansas initiative. "The \$2,000 grant we received from the council played a pivotal role in our ability to coordinate this local project and display the exhibit here at the museum." Taylor added that people who didn't get a chance to sign up in the fall still have an opportunity

to include their business in the master archive of photos. Those who are interested can send a photo, either a professional or amateur picture, to the museum. There is no cost for inclusion. Include the name of the business and who is shown in the picture. The exhibit will be on display until Wednesday, Feb. 27. of Dresden. The report said the driver, Abagile Gifford, 18, Colby, was flown by air ambulance to Via Christi St. Francis Hospital in Wichita. She was wearing a seat belt, the patrol said. A passenger, Heather Toal, 19, Hillsboro, was taken to the Sheridan County Health Complex in Hoxie, the report says. She had not been wearing a seat belt, the report said. The other passengers, Ashley Elsasser, 21, Clifton; Samantha Janson, 18, Colby; and Arielle Gil-Sanz, 19, Manhattan, were checked at the scene. The report said neither Janson nor Gil-Sanz was wearing a safety restraint.

Hawaii. However, college officials refused to confirm the women were enrolled. Dr. Keegan Nichols, vice president of student affairs and marketing, said federal privacy laws prevented her from saying whether they were students. Athletic Director Ryan Sturdy did confirm that Gifford was a freshman middle blocker on the volleyball team. He said she had been released from the hospital Saturday. "It's unfortunate anytime we have any of our Colby Community College students in an accident," Sturdy said. "I'm just thankful everyone was OK and it ended up not being as serious as it could have been." Jennings Fire Chief Kerry Green said one of the girls told him all were students. "The girls were all going to college in Colby," he said. "I talked with the one girl and she said they were all college buddies."

In the wreck Saturday, Trooper Gizzarelli reported that the driver, Gordon Gail Gibson, 23, was southbound from Leoville when his 1997 Toyota Tacoma pickup went off the right side of the highway just north of the county line, came back on, then flipped onto its right side and rolled down the road. When firemen and ambulance crews arrived, he was reported as "code blue," not breathing. The passenger, Parker James Gibson, 22, was taken to the Decatur County Hospital, which refused to comment on his condition. "I don't know if the driver fell asleep or what," Harms said, "but I think he did, because he hit a post and a sign before over-correcting and rolling down the road. "Unfortunately he died, so we can't ask him. It's tragic as heck to be that young and killed that way."
