County OKs money for jail work

tions that can be bid to construction companies usually takes six months.

He added that he is not sure if the commissioners will want a cheaper project than what his firm comes up with, or if they will back out of the project altogether.

If the project does go forward, he said, the \$5,000 will be added to the firm's fee.

"This is a good time to (build something), because interest

rates are about as low as they are going to go," Steele said.

He told the other commissioners that the county is authorized to sell \$2 million in bonds, but that will not be enough.

The new jail building might include a "judicial center" with a courtroom and office space for judicial staff, he said, so that prisoners do not have to be taken from the jail building to the courthouse, as is done now.

He said the firm will talk with the employees who will use the facility to find the most secure

way to design it.

"There's more driving this than just the fact that we're running out of space in our jail," Steele said after the meeting.

When the current Law Enforcement Center was built, he said, the county had a \$2 million budget and cut away different parts of the building until it met the right cost.

"All those omissions are pretty important in and of themselves," he said. "We're looking at what is it going to cost to remedy those deficiencies."

Undersheriff Marc Finley said that improvements needed at the jail include a kitchen, rooms for storage, laundry, visitation, interviews, interrogation, a larger booking room, a better exercise area and a "sally port" at the entry-way for taking prisoners in and out.

Steele also said the firm will look into a new site for the jail, which could include a place off the site of the current building.

He said he has several places in mind, but could not say where.

Republicans fault speech for liberalism

that Obama offered little more than "gimmicks and tax hikes."

Obama used his speech Tuesday night to call for action on a sweeping agenda that included the economy, guns, immigration, taxes and climate change. New initiatives included proposals

to improve preschool programs and voting, boost manufacturing and research and development, raise the minimum wage and lower energy use.

His remarks seemed to have little persuasive effect on Republicans who control the House and hold enough votes to stall legislation in the Senate and be-

lieve that government helps best by getting out of the way.

House Budget Committee Chairman Paul Ryan, the GOP's vice presidential candidate last fall, said today that Obama's leadership style stands in the way of bipartisan efforts to resolve problems like the deficit.

The morning-after comments

came as Obama was getting ready to take off on a three-state trip, starting in North Carolina, to sell voters on the programs he outlined. The president had hit the road frequently in campaign-style trips in December to argue the approach he favored for avoiding the so-called "fiscal cliff."
