The trio entered, found Campbell and Cook in bed together, then retreated to the kitchen to talk about what to do about it. They agreed to leave. Urban and Dellere walked toward the door, Romine said, but Coryell took a shotgun, which was standing against the wall when they first entered the house, and killed Cook while he slept.
