Such a holding would be consistent with his
one-notrump bid and his spade play at trick two. Note that if you lead any club other than the jack at trick three, South can make the contract with
proper play. a doubt, lead a diamond to the jack, play the nine of hearts and let it ride. Even if the finesse loses,
you are certain of at least nine tricks -- one spade, three hearts, four diamonds and a club.
You cannot afford to take a spade finesse at
trick two because South might win with the king and return a club, and you'd finish behind the eight ball if North started with the A-Q-10-x-x of clubs.
