# Four from Brewster compete at state today

Dan Brown jumped 6-0 for second place in the high jump. In the two-mile run, Layton Werth qualified in third, followed by Ben Baird in fourth, with times of 10:35:59 and 10:36:06.

Werth ran the mile in 5:01:16 to take fourth place. Nathan Jorgensen threw the javelin for a personal best distance of 153'6" to take fourth.

So far today, Baird took 10th place in the two-mile and Werth took 11th.
