Friday crash briefly closes interstate

Two people were sent to the hospital – one apparently with serious injuries – in separate car accidents Friday morning and Saturday evening.

The Kansas Highway Patrol, worked both accidents. It reported that a man was thrown from a truck Friday after he went off the side of Interstate 70 near Brewster.

Delbert W. Majors, 73, Oakley was headed west when he crashed at 11:10 a.m. Friday. Majors went off the road at milemarker 35, a mile and a half west of Brewster. He then over-corrected the 2007 Dodge truck he was driving and went across both lanes of traffic. Majors, who was not wearing a seatbelt, was thrown from the truck when it flipped over in the ditch on the north side of the road.

Traffic was backed up about half a mile as emergency responders arrived at the scene. They took Majors to the Citizens Medical Center here, where he was treated, stabilized and sent to another hospital. Hospital staff could not say where. Then the truck had to be towed from the side of the road.

The second accident sent a Brewster teen went to the hospital after he and some friends were driving down back roads in Rawlins County Saturday.

Julius Felzien, 14 was riding in a 1993 Ford F 150 headed south on Rawlins County Road 9. The driver, Nathaniel Joseph

Brown, 15, stopped to turn west on County Road G5, six miles southeast of McDonald at 7:02 p.m. Saturday. A 1989 Chevrolet Camaro that had been following the pickup hit it in the passenger side.

Brown was okay, but Julius Felzien went to Rawlins County

Hospital in Atwood. The driver of the Camaro, Clinton Mark Felzien Jr., 16, and passenger Quinton Clymer, 15 were both unhurt. The patrol reported that the four boys, who are from Brewster, were each wearing a seatbelt.

Internship program deadline extended

The deadline for college juniors, seniors, graduate and law students to apply for the Kansas Governor's Internship Program has been extended. Students have until Friday, Aug. 30, to submit their applications for the fall internship program.

The program is designed to give students hands-on experience of working in state government and allow students the opportunity to contribute to improving Kansas.

Internship specialization opportunities in the governor's office include positions in appointments, communications, constituent services, legal, lieutenant governor, First Lady, budget and policy as well as the Hispanic and Latino Affairs Commission, the African American Affairs Commission, Kansas Commission on Disability Concerns, the Governor's Grant Program, and the Native American Affairs Commission.

Each cabinet-level agency also offers opportunities for interns, including: Labor, Commerce, Revenue, Transportation,

Agriculture, Adjutant General, Aging and Disability Services, Highway Patrol, Administration, Securities Commission, Corrections, Juvenile Justice Authority, Children and Families, Wildlife, Parks and Tourism, Health and Environment and the Kansas Department of Education.

The fall internship program runs from September to December, and students are expected to work at least 16 hours per week. Some internships may be paid. All interested students must submit an internship application from the governor's website, along with a current resume, signed consent form, two letters of recommendation, a statement of interest and an optional writing sample.

Completed applications are due by Friday, Aug. 30; applications received after this date will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. Information about the internship program can be found at governor.ks.gov/ks-serv/governor-office-internship-program.
