showed pictures. Each had built ponds to grow the fish with platforms above them for plants inside small sheds that were heated in different ways.

Hill has raised 120 full-size tilapia she obtained as fingerlings and plans to breed her own. She had been told they grew from one gram to 50 grams in size, and quickly learned she needed more space for them when she saw how big a 50-gram fish is. But she pointed out that they are a favorite of Americans for eating, and are generally imported from China.

"There's no reason that we should be eating Chinese tilapia," Hill said. "You should all be raising your own tilapia, right?"

Jared Hoyle, an assistant professor with

K-State, stepped up next to explain how to be applied at the right time and in the right care for turf grass. Colby is near a transition zone, Hoyle said, where "it's too hot to grow some grasses and it's too cold to grow

He told the group about cold-weather grasses like tall fescue and Kentucky bluegrass, and heat-loving varieties like bermuda grass and buffalo grass. The latter is his favorite: it's the only kind of turf grass he listed that is native to North America, and requires little water and nutrients.

Weeds, Hoyle said, are the result of an unhealthy yard, because healthy grass can keep out competing plants. He went over means to identify what kind of weeds are in a lawn, in order to buy the right weedkiller. Certain similar weedkillers have the same active ingredients, he said, and should

quantities to kill the weeds and leave the lawn alive.

The next presenter failed to show up, so Zimmerman and Dr. Alan Stevens, the state floriculture specialist for the extension system, led a tour of the grounds. Rain came back near the start of that tour, and the audience had been weeded down to about 25

The plants on display included hardy desert varieties like helenium. It's a yellow flower native to west Texas, which survived very well in what Stevens called the worst summer in 15 years for growing flowers. But they also included tropical plants like banana trees, papyrus, colocasia, known as elephant ear, and poisonous oleanders.
