

# Purple Heart carrier passes

American Legion Riders' Patriot Guard - some from out of town, and Doug Ketchum, who is connected to the American Legion here - talking about what has happened since. The guard members have been riding with Gregory on her way to meet Peggy for the first time at her home in Carson City, Nev.

After seeing what was in the box, Gregory said, she took an interest in who Peggy's father was. She spent years researching everything about the man and his relatives, not any easy task in the days before "social media" websites. Originally from the town Leadwood, near St. Louis, she said, John Eddington is buried at the Jefferson Barracks National Cemetery, less than 15 minutes from Gregory's home.

He enlisted in the Army in 1941, joining the 168th Infantry Regiment, Company K, and married Helen Cash in April 1942. Gregory said that a woman who worked at the Leadwood City Hall helped her find the Eddingtons' marriage certificate and wedding announcement. His name is on a stone monument in Leadwood dedicated to soldiers killed in both world wars.

Peggy was born in Missouri while John was stationed in Texas, ready to go to war. John Eddington never met his daughter, but he wrote her a letter on Feb. 27, 1944, three weeks and one day after she was born and four months before he was killed on June 27, 1944. He was awarded the Purple Heart after his death.

Over the years, Gregory said, she cold-called everyone she could find with the last names Eddington and Cash. Later, she discovered that Peggy moved to Nevada when she was an adult. Smith, so her children have different last names. row down the search.

Since she had learned about Peggy, Gregory knew she turned 69 this year. She never found a death certificate, but became desperate as she realized she might die of old age before ever seeing her father's things.

In what she described as a sacrifice of privacy, Gregory put pictures of the documents on Face-

book. That turned up plenty of leads, and Gregory eventually found one of Peggy's kids and one of her grandkids at the same time on the website and sent them messages.

"As soon as Peggy got home," she said, "they had her call me."

That was late May or early June, she said. She got the call at a restaurant where she was having dinner with some old high school friends. Peggy's husband called and turned the phone over to his

"She said, 'Hi, this is Peggy, you're looking for me,' and I started bawling like a baby," Gregory

In fact, she was so overcome with emotion she had to step outside. She asked Smith if she knew about the letters or if she knew her grandparents. Smith wanted to know how she found the papers, and Gregory soon learned that she had never known about them.

"She asked me questions, I asked her, questions," Gregory said, "and then it turned to, 'I will get this stuff to you."

But she needed some more help to do that, this time money. Gregory and her friends got themselves on a local television program sponsored by American Equity Mortgage called "Pay it Forward," which loans \$500 to someone in need.

She learned about the Patriot Guard when she found another story about someone trying to return a Purple Heart, and got in touch with the organization. Guard members offered to ride with her from St. Louis to Carson City. Ed Hemmenway and Emery Barg, who she met the morning she left St. Louis, were with her when she passed through Colby.

She got on a three-wheeler motorcycle Wednes-She married several times before marrying Kevin day morning as she set out for Wyoming by way of Colorado, with just over half a dozen riders. Her current surname, however, did nothing to nar- Her sister, Brenda Allen, and friend Monica Lightfoot rode along with the group in a car.
