Bake coconut for easy shelling

Dear Heloise: I enjoyed meeting you at an event in Houston. I love fresh coconut, but after I drain the coconut and crack the shell, it takes major surgery to get the meat out. I enjoyed meeting you and your daughter; please give her a hug for me! Trying to crack a coconut can drive you "nuts"! The coconut needs to be baked before the meat is removed.

Put the coconut in the oven (on 350 F) for 15-20 minutes. Remove carefully and wrap in a heavy towel. Use a hammer to whack the heck out of it. Just keep hammering away, and it should break into pieces, which makes it easier to remove the

where she had found the big, wide rubber bands that are so handy for large extension cords, boxes in the pantry, etc. She said that when her rubber gloves develop holes, she cuts across the cuffs to form the wide bands. Not only handy, but a great way to recycle.

Another hint is that after dropping a piece of eggshell into a light-colored batter and not finding it, I now keep a stack of disposable, clear plastic cups in the kitchen. Defusing a Threat

In many hands, declarer finds it more dangerous to have one opponent on lead than the other. This is usually because the dangerous opponent, by gaining the lead, can either run a long suit or return a suit that threatens a key card in the dummy or declarer's hand. Consider the present deal, where South's over-

riding concern should be to keep East off lead in order to prevent a potentially killing lead through the king of spades. Declarer's first step in this direction should


be to play low from dummy on West's jack-ofclubs lead, and then also play low from his hand. He should not put up the queen. If he does, East might subsequently gain the lead with a club, while if he doesn't, East can never gain the lead with a club. Let's say West continues with a club and South

takes East's king with the ace. Pursuing his aim to keep East out of the lead, declarer cashes the A-Q of trumps and returns a diamond from dummy, covering East's eight with the ten. South's avoidance policy now pays off because

West, on lead with the queen of diamonds, can do declarer no harm. In fact, if West doesn't cash the ace of spades at this point, he loses it. Playing in this fashion does not constitute an especially brilliant feat on declarer's part. It


