

Hays company awarded old U.S. 24 paving contract

in the loop around the energy center, Northern Sun and on Eighth Street he did not think it was a good idea to cut back on the work planned for Eighth Street.

Commissioner Kevin Rasure, who was on speaker phone for the meeting, asked DeBoer if he had refigured Eighth Street with the lower prices that came in on the old U.S. 24 bids?

DeBoer said he had refigured Eighth Street and it was \$2.4 million, which was about \$400,000 less than the original estimated of \$2.8 million. He said he figured Road 16 to be \$500,000, down about \$300,000 from his first estimate.

Rasure asked DeBoer if he had talked to Kyle Railroad about the crossing on Road 16?

DeBoer said he had talked to the Kyle Railroad people, and they are willing to put the new concrete crossing in, but want to be paid for the materials.

Commissioner Mitch Tiede said that was similar to what the county had done on the crossing at Caruso.

Mayor Rick Billinger said that was a similar arrangement the city made

to redo the crossing at Cattle Trail. DeBoer said he would plan in about a 100 foot concrete apron on each side of the crossing, and the rest would be asphalt.

DeBoer said because of the snow he has not been able to do the survey work on Road 16, and to get Eighth Street moving they may have to do the two as separate contracts. He said he thought he could have Eighth Street ready to go to bid by March.

Billinger asked if DeBoer couldn't figure the one mile of asphalt for Road 16 in with Eighth Street.

DeBoer said he did not want to do that because of the extra road work that has to be done on Road 16.

Tiede said Road 16 is going to take some extra dirt work because of drainage issues.

Billinger asked if DeBoer couldn't bid both together, but put a later starting date on Road 16.

DeBoer said that could be done if the county was doing the dirt work to get Road 16 ready.

Tiede said the commissioners had talked about having the county crew do the dirt work, but had not made a firm decision. He said the decision on that could not be done

until after DeBoer gets the survey done to determine what is needed, and if the county could do it.

"If the county was going to do all the base work," DeBoer said, "then we could let it at the same time as Eighth Street."

"Can we do that and negotiate with the contractor who is going to do Eighth?" Rasure asked.

"The county would have to do the dirt work," Tiede said.

Way said the decision would have to wait until the survey could be completed, but felt there was a little more time to look at that.

Billinger said it would be good to lock the asphalt price in while the contractor was here, and before the prices went back up.

On the bid for old U.S. 24 Rasure said he thought the low bid was acceptable, and said they should go with the second option, which included the subgrade work over by Edson.

"We are not using the millings on the top asphalt layer," Rasure said. "We are using the millings in the base lift."

Tiede said that was the plan, and that not using the millings on the top gives the road a better surface.

"For \$180,000 we can go with

option 2," Commissioner Chuck Thomas said.

DeBoer said in the bid on old U.S. 24 the bid on the subgrade work was a good bid.

Rasure asked how much of the sales tax bond money had been spent so far?

County Clerk Janet Rumpel said the county has paid over \$300,000 so far.

"Where are we money wise with the two-year window?" Rasure asked.

Rumpel said under the bonding the county should have spent \$1.2 million by March 15.

DeBoer said the county might be able to pre-pay some materials on the old U.S. 24 project and possibly on the city projects.

Rasure suggested that DeBoer, Rumpel, City Clerk Mary Volk and Neufeld, engineer for Evans, Bierly, Hutchison and Associates, who are handling the city project, get together and see what can be done to pre-pay about \$900,000 to

meet the March 15 target.

Billinger said it was great that the

projects were coming in under bud-

get.
