

# Goodland plays Hoxie tonight

The Goodland Cowboys will wrap up league basketball play with tough back-to-back games at Max Jones Fieldhouse, facing the fifth-ranked Class 2A Hoxie Indians tonight and the Colby Eagles on Saturday.

Both games will begin at 7 p.m. and will be broadcast on KLOE Radio, 730 AM or on the Internet through network1sports.com.

The Colby game was postponed from Tuesday because of snow on Monday and icy roads.

Cowboy Coach Jon McLean said these will be tough games. "Both teams are solid and will provide good competition for us," he said.

The Cowboys' season record is 12-6. The Cowboys are 5-0 in league play, having beaten Oakley, St. Francis, Atwood, Oberlin and Quinter.

Hoxie comes in with an 11-1 record but only 4-1 in league. Their loss was to Atwood back in December. Hoxie will face St. Francis on Tuesday in a rescheduled league game.

Colby's record is 8-8, and 3-1 in the league. Colby faces Atwood tonight and St. Francis Thursday to complete their league games.

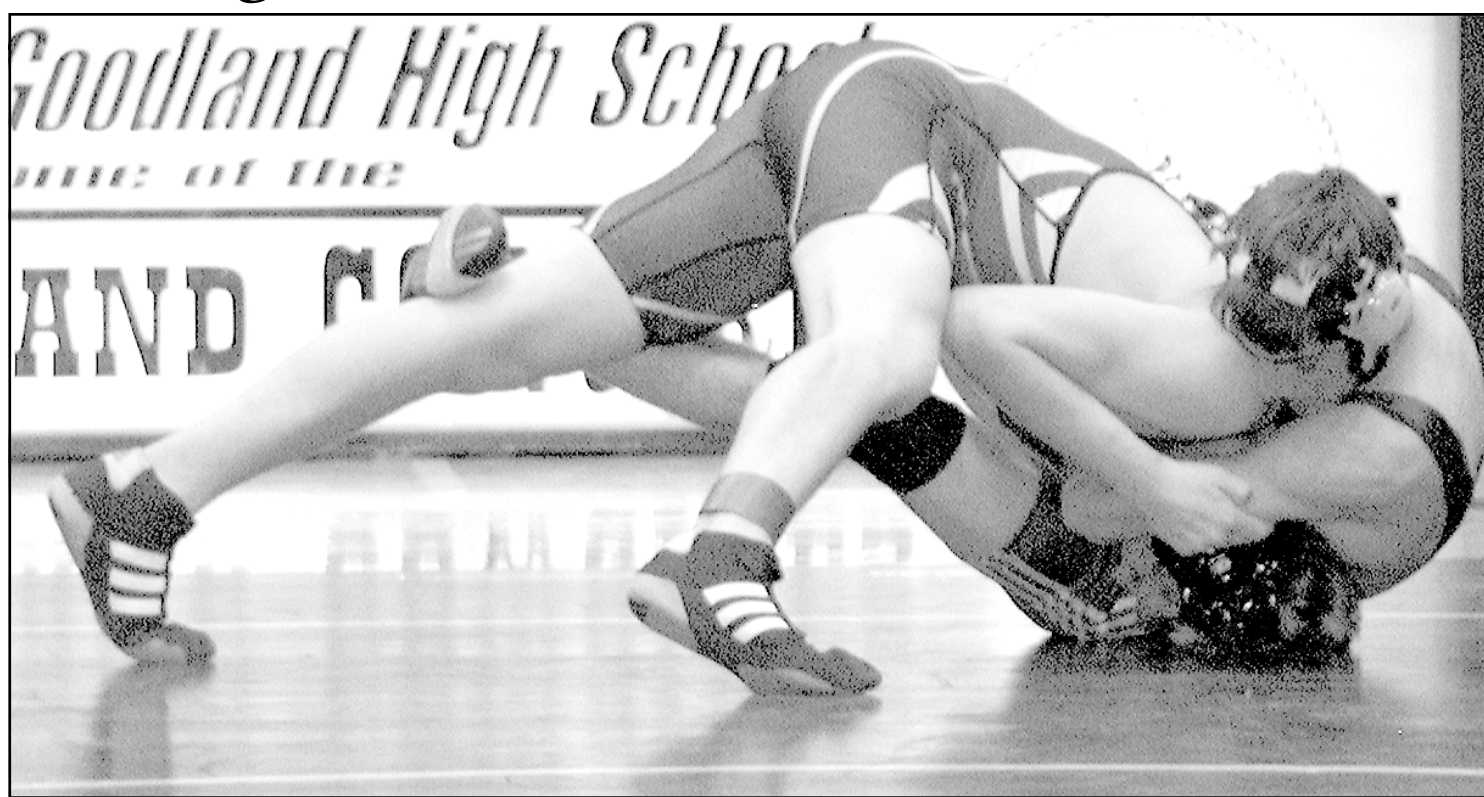

# Ex-Cowboy ranked No. 1

Former Goodland High wrestler Brett Bahe, now a senior at Great Bend High School, is ranked No. 1 at 130 pounds in Class 5A by the Kansas Wrestling Coaches Association heading into Saturday's regional meet in Hutchinson.

Bahe was a two-time Class 4A

state champion as a Cowboy, winning the title at 112 pounds in 2004 as a sophomore and at 119 pounds last year. He finished fourth at 103 pounds his freshman year.
