

# Third night wild, but no injuries at races

Two cars in the bomber class rolled in the main race Saturday, but no one was injured during the third night of racing at Sherman County Speedway.

Alex West, Speedway Association president, said two of the front running cars in the bomber class rolled on turn two during the main race. He said Raymond Dechant (00) and Adam Morris (S27) both of Lamar, Colo. got tangled and rolled with another car driven by Clinton Hockersmith (16X) of Oakley going over the hoods of the other cars.

West said the Sherman County Rural Fire department and the Goodland Regional Medical Center ambulance were both on scene, but there were no injuries.

The wreck ended Dechant's try for this third win this season. Jimmy Jenkins (97J) of Lamar was the winner of the bomber main with Travis King (05) of Sharon Spring second, Matt Morris (21M) of Lamar third, Joey Snethen (S98) of Goodland fourth.

King had spun out a couple times in the preliminary race, but got things under control to finish second in the main race.

In the econo class things got pretty wild as a couple of the drivers kept getting tangled in turn two in the preliminary races. Drivers Cody Pancake (40) of Sharon Springs and T.J. Yarger (00) of Goodland bumped several times and got flagged for bumping each other. Pancake had to retire before the end of the preliminary with a flat tire.

The stock class was a bit thin this time and Angel Munoz (95N) and Jimmy Jenkins (97J), both of Lamar, raced each other with Munoz winning. Munoz won his third race in the stock class.

Christopher Kleine (11) of Las Cruces, N.M. ran away from the competition in the mini class to take his third checkered flag.

His father Don Kleine watched from the sidelines because he had wrecked his car at the races in Norton, and his new car was not ready. Don Kleine said he and his son have been coming up from New

Mexico to clean up their land in Burlington to get it ready for sale. He said they work during the week, and come to Goodland to relax. He said the new business is doing well, and said he will be back with a new car for the next races.

In the modified class Darren DeLoach (21) of Lamar, Colo. returned to his track form and had a long lead to win his second main. He led the race from the beginning. Chris Lueck (331) finished second, and Brady Coen (3) of Lamar worked his way up from the back to finish third. Jeff Tubbs (37) of Colby was fourth, and Dwayne Dechant (2d) of Lamar was fifth. Chris Remetes (10) of Denver was

sixth. Seven more nights of racing are scheduled, on Saturdays June 16; July 7 and 21; Aug. 18; and Sept. 1, and the weekend of Sept. 28 and 29.

The 1200 Outlaw Sprints will appear July 21, and the 305 Sprint cars are expected for the 15th annual Bill Gray Memorial on Aug. 18. The 18th annual Flatlander Fall Classic will be Friday and Saturday, Sept. 28 and 29.
