

Senior begins final season

Goodland native Alisha McKee begins her final season of college volleyball on Saturday, Aug. 24, when the Lady Bulldogs of California State University, Fresno play in the Husky Classic at the University of Washington.

Two weeks after opening the season in Washington McKee and her teammates will be in Manhattan to play in the Varney's Kansas State Invitational.

McKee is one of three seniors returning to the Fresno State lineup. Last season she played in 27 of 30 matches for the Bulldogs starting 14.

McKee was third on the team in kills with 227 and fifth in blocks with 35.

Fresno State finished 6-24 overall and was 3-13 in the Western Athletic Conference.

The Bulldogs are picked to finish eighth in the conference coaches' preseason poll released Monday.

The Rainbow Wahine of the University of Hawaii is the top pick of the coaches to win their 12th straight conference title.

Other teams in the tournament are Northern Iowa and Arkansas.

Alisha, the daughter of Jerry and Linda McKee of Goodland, graduated from Goodland High in 2004 after helping lead the Cowgirls to the 2003 state Class 4A championship.

She was an All-Northwest Kansas League pick her sophomore, junior and senior seasons. Alisha also lettered in basketball and track as a Cowgirl.

New Mexico State was second in the coaches' preseason poll with San Jose State and Idaho tied for third.

Nevada fifth followed by Boise State, sixth, and Utah State, seventh. Louisiana Tech ended up ninth.
