

Mustangs beat Rawlins County 46-14

Goodland eighth grade takes lead in second half

What started out as a very close game opened up in the second half to Grant's favor to give the eighth grade Mustangs a win, 46-14 over Rawlins County.

In the second half the Mustangs scored on several long drives, and even had a safety late in the fourth quarter.

Coach Gregory Craig was pleased with the effort of his team.

Riley Oharah (30) was the leading rusher with 86 yards for 3 touchdowns and 1 two-point conversion. Ryder Kling (22) had 25 yards, and 1 two-point conversion. Caleb Fugleberg (20) had 25 yards; Laine Herl ran for 15 yards including 1 touchdown and 1 two-point conversion; and Reed Bellamy (12) had 11 yards for 1 rushing touchdown and 1 two-point conversion.

In the passing game Bellamy had 4 completions for 80 yards; Ryan Hillmer (10) had 1 completion for 28 yards and a touchdown; and Oharah completed a pass on a two-point conversion.

On the defensive side of the ball Craig said the Mustangs played well.

Oharah led the defense with 9 tackles. Jason Cowan (65) had 4 tackles and one was for the safety. Dallas DeLaRosa had 4 tackles.

Avelar and Brendan Fulcher (56) each had 3 tackles; Bellamy, Fugleberg, Herl and Garrett Geist (80) each had 2 tackles.

Hillmer, J.J. Farris (11), Kling, Joel Linin (41), Mac Purvis (53), Tyler Fisher (50), Mikail Freeman (59), and Sloan Ruhs (66) each had 1 tackle. Parker Sieck (43) had 1 interception and 1 tackle.

The Mustangs faced Burlington at Cowboys Stadium on Tuesday, and will be on the road in Garden City on Sept. 26. The Mustangs will be at Cowboys Stadium at 3:30 p.m. on Thursday, Sept. 27 when they face Oakley.

"We started off serving very well in game one but our serves dropped off in games two and three," said Coach Denise White. "The girls did a good job with block coverage but just could not get things rolling like in the first game."

First game highlights — Jamie Gittinger leading server. Served 12 straight points, with two aces. Nicole Hendrich and Katelyn Coon both served 3 each with

Audrey Titus and Page Seeger serving 2 each. The teams overall serving average for game one was 87 percent.

Second game - Gittinger and Hendrich both lead the team with 5 serves each. Followed by Titus and Taylor Peden with 4 each. The teams overall serving average for game two was 70 percent.

Third game — Katelyn Coon lead the team with 4 serves with Titus having 2 serves. The teams overall serving average for game three was 77 percent.

The Lady Mustangs A Team lost both games of the match to Rawlins County 25-14 in the first game and 25-17 in the second game.

"Overall the girls played well," White said. "Our block coverage looked good also. We just need to learn how to get back up when we

are down."

Goodland native Whitney Dautel and her teammates on the Sterling College cross country teams will be at Cottonwood Point near the Marion reservoir Saturday for their fourth meet of the season.

Dautel, a freshman in her first season at Sterling, led the Lady Warriors in their last two meets. At the University of Central Missouri's Mule Run on Sept. 7, Dautel placed 44th overall out of 108

running the four kilometer course, about 2.5 miles, in 17 minutes, 9.6 seconds. Sterling's women finished ninth among the 11 teams competing.

Whitney, a 2007 graduate of Goodland High, is the daughter of John Dautel and Coleen Dautel of Goodland.

Last Saturday in Lubbock, Texas, Dautel finished 47th out of 88 in the women's race at Texas

Tech's Red Raider Jackrabbit Open. Dautel completed the three miles in 20:45.8 with three of her teammates crossing the finish line less than a minute behind her. The Lady Warriors finished eighth out of 10 teams.

After Saturday's meet Sterling's runners will have two weeks to prepare for their next competition on Saturday, Oct. 6, at the McPherson Country Club.

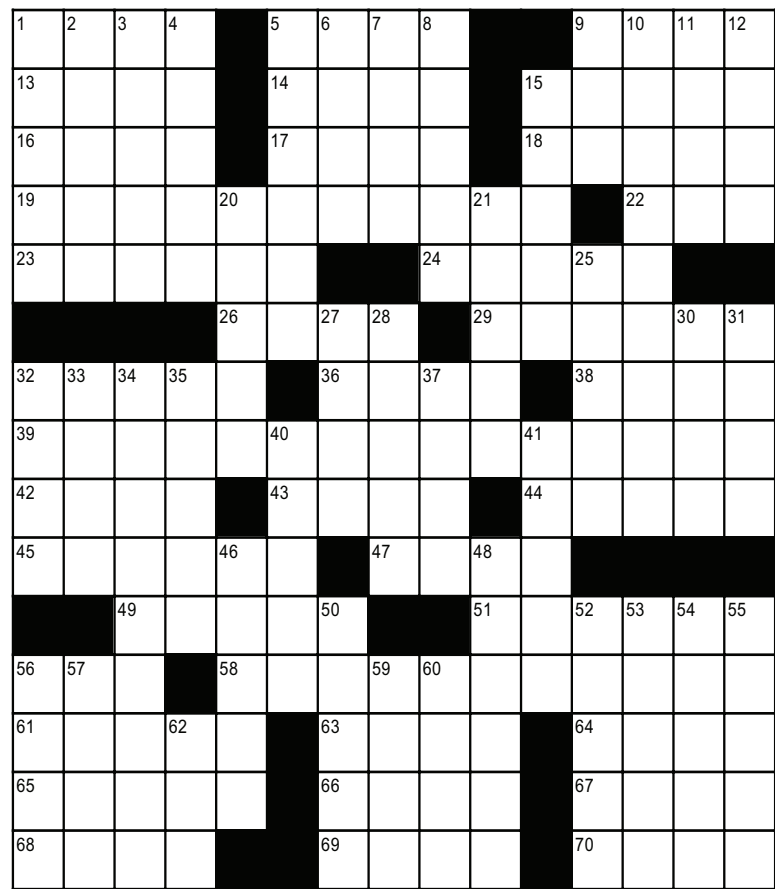
