Petition for Charter Amendment 29

On September 14, 2007, the Municipal Energy Agency of Nebraska (MEAN) filed a Petition with the Nebraska Power Review Board (Board) requesting approval of an amendment to its charter. This would be the twenty-ninth time the agency has amended its charter. The purpose of the proposed amendment is to add the municipalities of Ansley, Nebraska, Pierce, Nebraska, and Wisner, Nebraska as voting members of MEAN and to withdraw Goodland, Kansas as a voting member of MEAN. A copy of the entire Petition and all exhibits is available by contacting the Board at the address or phone number below.

Notice is hereby given that the Nebraska Power Review Board will consider approval of the above-referenced Petition during its public meeting on October 26, 2007, beginning at 9:00 a.m. at Omaha Public Power District Energy Plaza, 444 South 16th Street Mall, Omaha, Nebraska. At that time, the Board will review and consider any requests it has received in support of holding a public hearing.

Be advised that if the Board determines there is not sufficient interest to warrant a public hearing, the Board will consider approval of the Petition without a hearing during the Board's October 26, 2007 meeting.

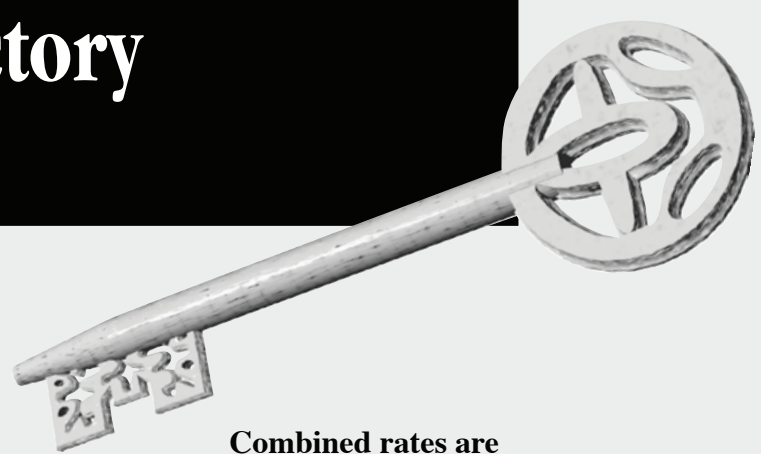
