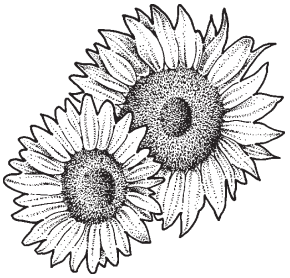

Congratulations, 4-H members on state fair honors

Projects earn ribbons, recognition

Twenty-seven Sherman County 4-H members recently exhibited their projects at the Kansas State Fair which was held Sept. 7-16 in Hutchinson.

To be eligible to exhibit at the state fair, they had to be 10 years of age or older and receive "state fair" ribbons in the Sherman County 4-H judging.

Three entries were selected for special recognition: Devin Mangus's pastel picture of a 1948 Massey-Harris tractor will be on display for a year at the Rock Springs 4-H Camp, Kade Sheldon's color photo was selected to be in a photo traveling selection and Kristina Stasser's color photo was selected to be part of a Washington D.C. display.

Life Skills judging participants were Brennen Clouse, T.J. Freeman, Jason Krayca and Stephanie Sheldon. Junior members participating in judging were Hope Cochran, Mikail Freeman and Garrett Nemecheck.

Reserve junior heifer calf, 1st place; early junior bull (Limousin), 1st place; Lim Flex bull, grand champion; champion bull calf (Limousin), 1st place; and overall champion bull (Limousin), reserve grand champion.
