The Emporia State University men's cross country team finished fourth at the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletic Association Championships held Saturday at the Kirksville Country Club, Kirksville, Mo.

Kerek Mason, former Goodland Cowboy, finished 66th in the men's race, and said the course was a lot like the Kansas state course at Wamego.

Kerek told his father, attorney Jeff Mason, there had been some rain and the course was a little soggy.

"The men met our goal to pull up into the upper division of the MIAA after finishing last a year ago," said Emporia Coach Dave Harris.

Kerek said he was thrilled with the team's finish and that one of his teammates, Sloane Kern, received the Freshman of the Year award by being the top freshman finisher in the race.

Kerek finished ninth on the Emporia State team. He probably won't get to run in the Regional race in

Joplin on Nov. 3. Jeff Mason said.

"The men ran very well," said Harris. "I thought Brock Ternes ran his best race ever in an ESU uniform."

The Hornets finished fourth as a team after placing eighth in 2006 and not fielding a team in 2005.

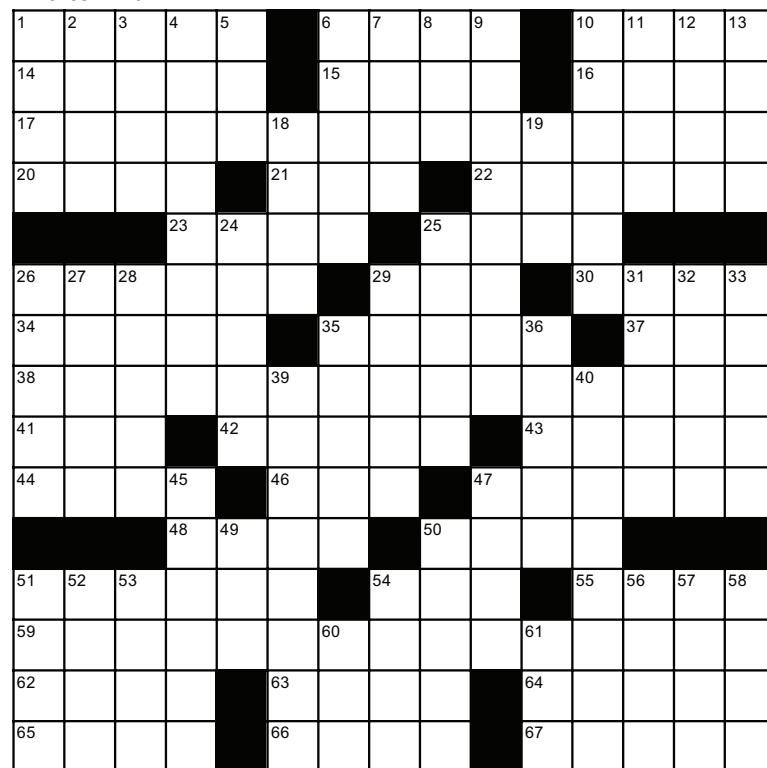
