The Grant Junior High Mustangs eighth-grade basketball team finished the season undefeated with a win over Rawlins County Buffaloes in the league championship, 49-33, on Dec. 13 at Max Jones Fieldhouse.

The eighth-grade Mustangs won 13 games this season before taking the league championship.

As seventh graders, this team went undefeated 13-0 and won the league title. For the two seasons combined, the teams was 26-0, including league and nonleague opponents.

The Mustangs defeated the St. Francis Indians on Dec. 10 to advance to the league semifinals. The Quinter Bulldogs gave the Mustangs a challenge in that game but Goodland won, 53-32.

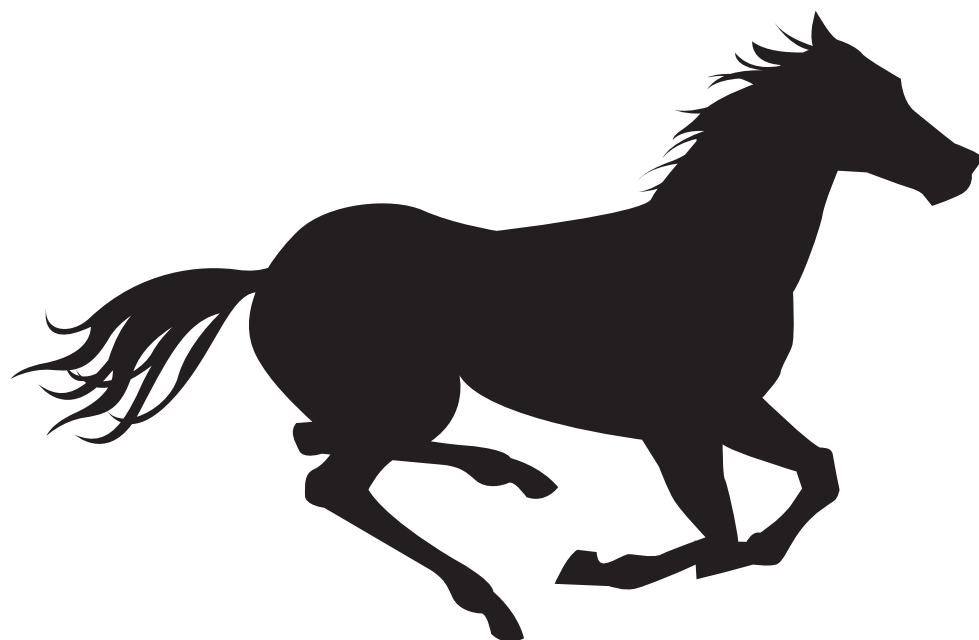
The Mustangs beat Rawlins County in the championship 49-33.

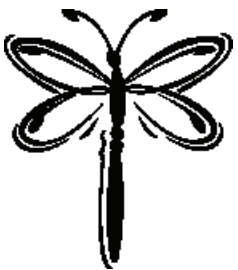

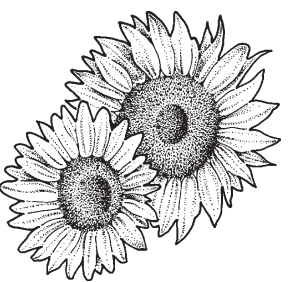
