Tye Faulkender, Dave Hovis, Justin Wright, Brent Olson and Brady Poppelreiter seated guests.

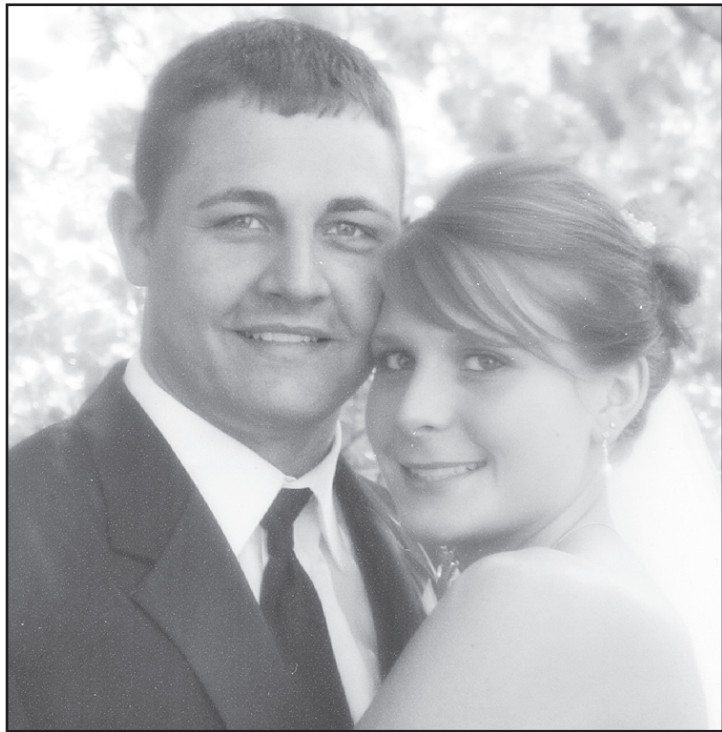
Candle lighters were Kerrie Olson and Cassie Cooper.

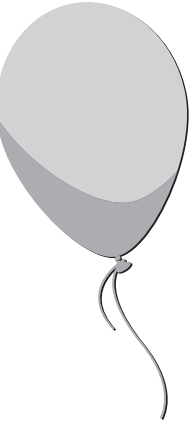

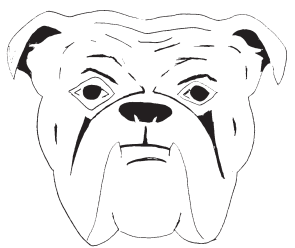

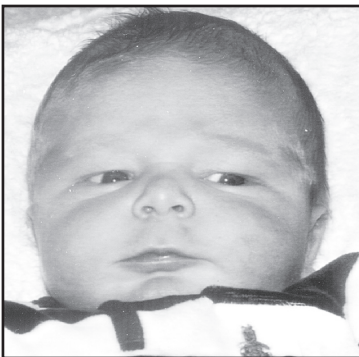
