The Cowboys also will wrestle today and Saturday, the varsity at Liberal and junior varsity at WaKeeney.


The basketball teams will be back in action tonight, when they face Lakin High at Max Jones Fieldhouse, the girls at 5:30 p.m. and the boys about 7.
