

Goodland has two champs at Oberlin

Team finishes fourth Saturday

The Cowboys had two champions, two in second and one in fourth at the Decatur County Invitational Wrestling Tournament Saturday in Oberlin but finished fourth out of nine teams.

Goodland had eight Cowboys and a Cowgirl compete at the Junior Prairie Classic junior varsity tournament in Hays. They had two champions, one in third and one in fourth with four not placing.

Five out of 12 wrestlers placed at Oberlin, said Coach Joseph Sramek, including two champions. Senior A.J. Stephens was first at 140 pounds with a 24-0 record, and senior Bob Doxon, 22-0, was first at 285. Stephens beat Trevor Rempe of Smith Center 2-1 in the finals, and Doxon pinned Derek Wilke of Kearney, Neb.

Junior Kade Sheldon was second at 112 with an 18-6 record, and senior Aaron Deeds, 23-2, was second at 152. Senior Ren Scherling, 15-12, was fourth at 215. Sheldon was pinned by Tim Crocker of Kearney in the finals, Deeds lost 9-5 to Travis Rempe of Smith Center and Scherling lost 6-2 to Cody Sparks of Kearney.

Goodland had 102.5 points as a team. Kearney was first with 238.5, Smith Center second with 154.5 and Oakley third with 106.

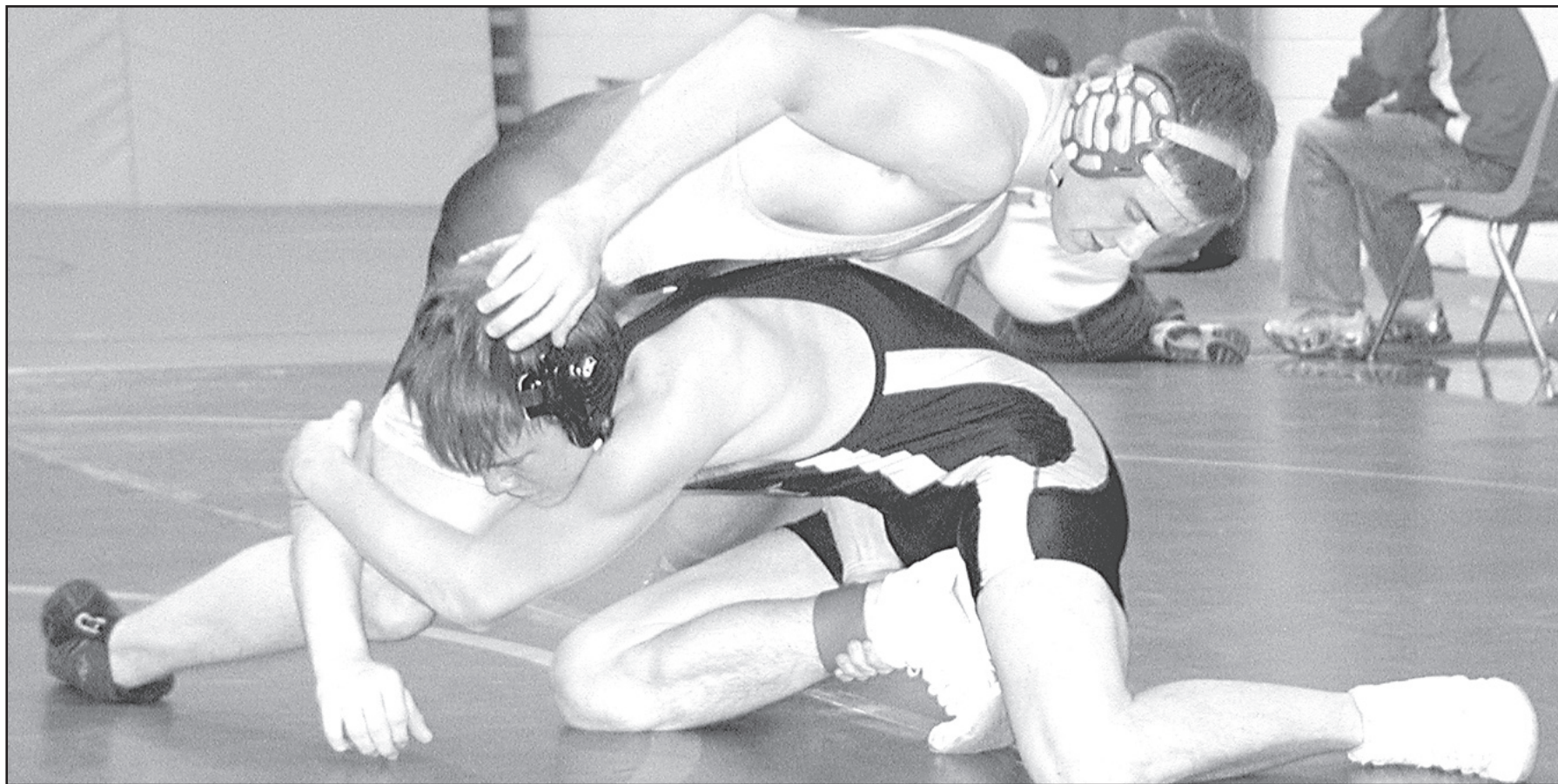
Behind Goodland were Osborne with 86, Oberlin with 77, McCook, Neb., with 63, Hill City with 38 and Quinter with 0.

"Overall as a team it was not our best performance of the year, as we finished fourth out of nine teams," Sramek said; "however, in a long season like wrestling, you will have your highs and lows, and you just want to be wrestling at your best at regional and state."

At Hays, junior Tanner Oharra was champion at 215 with a 3-0 record, and sophomore Jay Cotter, 3-0, was first at 285. Sophomore Paul Starr, 5-1, was third at 171, and sophomore Eduardo Martinez, 4-1, was third at 160. Junior Bryan Gray, 3-2, was fourth at 160.

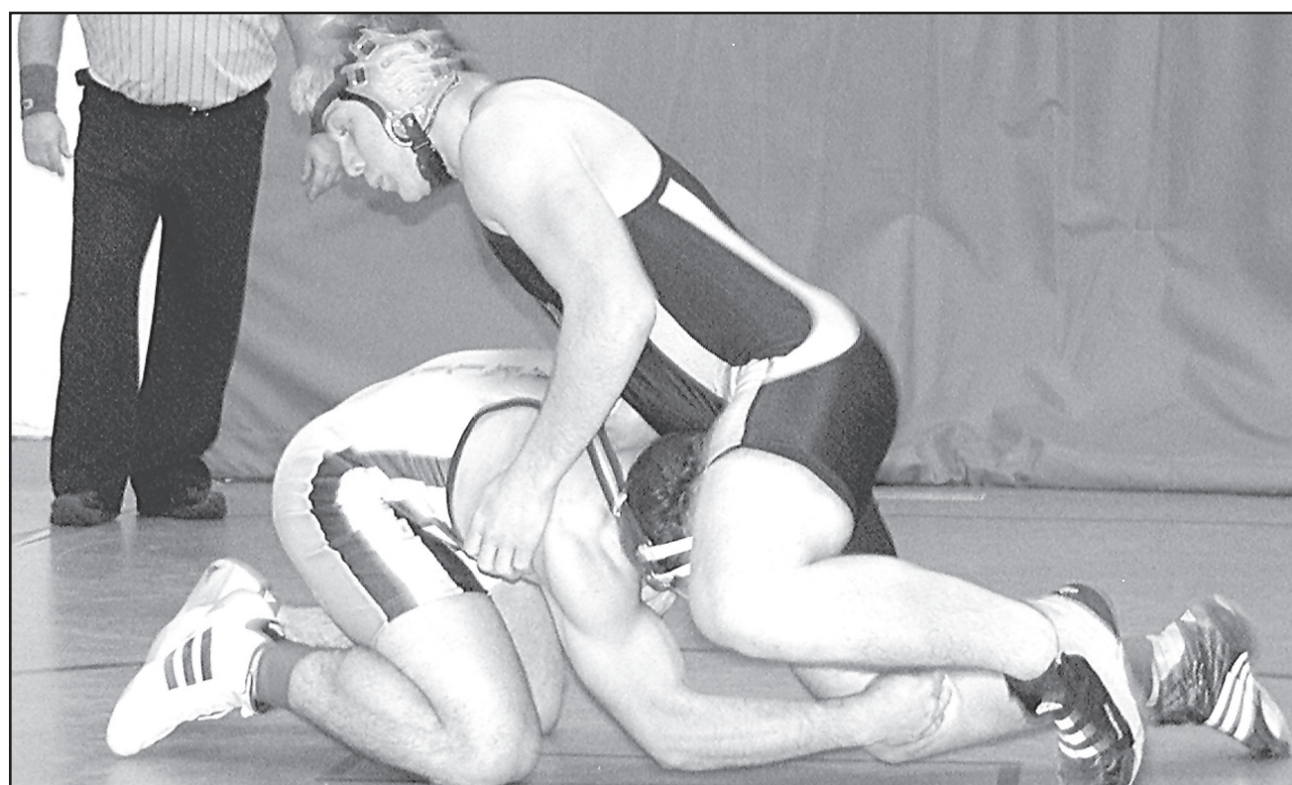

The junior varsity had an outstanding weekend, said Coach Steve Evert, and is improving each week.
