## Cowboys qualify seven for state wrestling

slcorcoran@nwkansas.com Goodland High finished third at the regional wrestling tournament, with seven wrestlers qualifying for state, two weight-class champions, two finishing second, two in third and one in fourth.

Cowboys senior Bob Doxon was voted regional Wrestler of the Year by the coaches.

As a team, Goodland had 142 points, behind first-place Colby with 213 and second-place Andale with 177.5. Behind Goodland were Pratt with 137.5, Mulvane with 79, Smoky Valley and Russell each with 70.5, Wellington with 58, Hugoton with 57, Hesston with 55, Buhler with 53, Clearwater with 46, Ulysses with 33, Haven with 26, Nickerson with 2 and Cheney

Senior A.J. Stephens won his weight class at 140 pounds, beating junior Brian Noller of Russell 9-3, while Doxon took the heavyweight championship by pinning senior Spencer Hilley of Clearwater in 47

Junior Ryan Taylor was second at 160 pounds, losing in the championship match 11-2 to senior Sam Thoman of Andale, and junior Fernando Martinez was second at 189, losing to junior Treat Bugbee of Colby 3-1.

Junior Keegan Smith beat junior Derick Cline of Wellington 8-6 for third at 145, and senior Aaron Deeds beat junior Derek Newell of Ulysses 9-6 for third at 152.

Junior Kade Sheldon lost his final match at regional 4-2 to Robbie Hines of Ulysses for fourth at 112.

"Overall, we had a good weekend," said Coach Joseph Sramek, "and I felt that all the wrestlers that competed did their very best."


A breakdown of the top four teams' number of qualifiers for state, he said, gives Colby 10, Andale eight, Pratt seven and Goodland seven.

"Next week at state," he said, "I feel we have an opportunity take home a lot of state placers. There will be some great wrestling, and it will be a fun experience."

The Cowboys entered regional competition ranked sixth among Class 4A teams by the Kansas Wrestling Coaches Association. They had four wrestlers in the state rankings. Doxon was ranked first at heavyweight, Stephens second at 140 pounds, Taylor fifth at 160 and Deeds sixth at 152.

Colby was ranked No. 1 Clay Center No. 2, Andale No. 3, Santa Fe Trail No. 4 and Labette County No. 5. Baldwin was No. 7, Paola No. 8, Abilene No. 9 and Chanute No. 10.


