Texas couple plan wedding in Hawaii

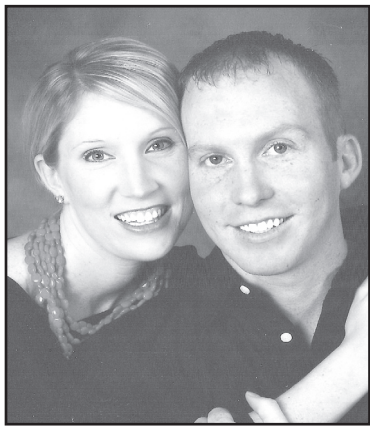
Kimberly Irene Kowalkowski and Kyle Adam Franklin plan to marry in April in Wallea, Maui, Hawaii.

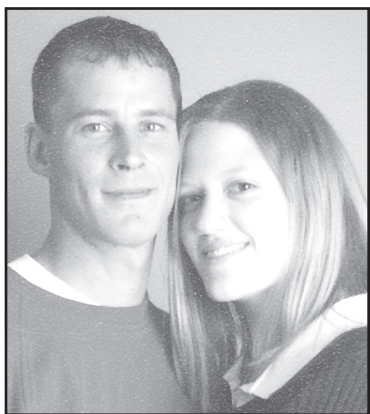
Pair to marry in April in Catholic Church
