



Scotty couldn't understand why some of the soldiers were mean to the people in Berlin. But he was proud that President Truman established the Berlin Airlift to send help to the people in need.

Thinking what it must have been like in Berlin at that time, Scotty looked around his room. It was warm in winter and cool in summer. The roof on his house kept the rain away. He had his own radio and television set. He had a nice bed and he even had a lamp that was shaped like a baseball with a red shade and white stars. And if he was hungry, he had plenty to eat.


Tired from reading, Scotty turned out his baseball lamp and lay in bed thinking about what he had read. He also thought
