Seven Goodland High students and two from Brewster High are among those receiving Dane G. Hansen Foundation scholarships this year:

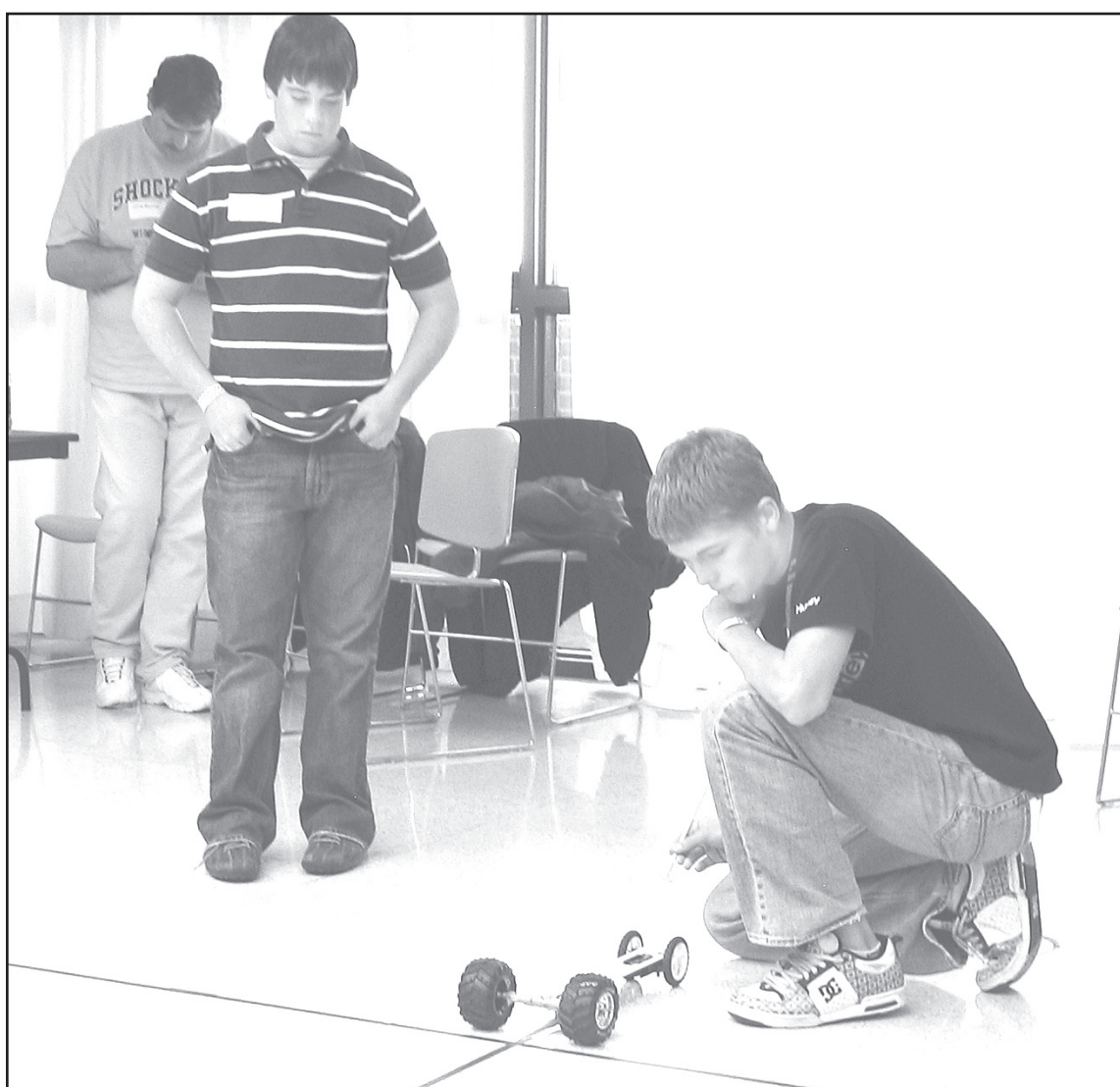
- Aaron Deeds, son of Robin and Carol Deeds won a \$3,000 Hansen Scholar award, renewable for another year.

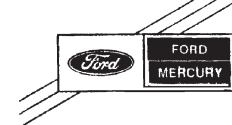
