# Fair winners featured at show

County fair livestock winners from 32 counties in three different states all converged on the Sherman County Fairgrounds on Saturday, Aug. 9, to compete against each other in the Tri-State Royal of Champions Livestock Show.

There were beef, sheep, swine and goats divisions. Animals and their handlers could compete in conformation, old pro and showmanship.

We had the largest number of sheep showing ever, said Marsha Schilling. There were 21 competitors.

Schilling Limousin, owned by Ron and Marsha Schilling, is in charge of the event, and it is sponsored by several area people and businesses. The Sherman County Fair Board pays for the judge. The judge was Wade Franklin from Lubbock, Texas. This was the 46th year for the event, Marsha Schilling said.

From Sherman County Clay Schilling won the grand championship in beef conformation, David

Rietcheck won the Old Pro. Kayler Rietcheck was third in the heifer conformation. Courtney Sheldon with her sheep won the Old Pro and was third in conformation. BreAnna Nemechek was third in the Old Pro in goats.

Reserve champion in beef conformation was Lane Crumley of Washington County, Colo. and third was Dayna Olson of Lincoln County, Neb. Kyla Clawson of Finney County won the grand championship in heifer conformation and Grace Hammer of Wallace County won the reserve championship.

Second in the Old Pro was Jenner Blach from Yuma County, Colo., and third was Brady Rundel of Thomas County.

In beef showmanship Grund Calahan from Wallace County won the grand championship, Kyla Clawson of Finney County the reserve champion and third was Jace Black of

Yuma County, Colo. In goat conformation Scott Chantelle of Ness County won the grand championship, Cassadie Copeland of Ford County second and Jessica Rudell of Logan County was third. In the Old Pro Cassadie Copeland of Ford County was first and Jessica Rudell second.

In sheep conformation Jandy Dunn of Cheyenne County won the grand championship, Kiesha Scott of Scott County second and Cheyenne Wiley of Bourbon County third. In the Old Pro second went to Ashlynn Schlochtermeyer of Russell County and third to Sarah Jamison of Greeley County. In showmanship Jamie Briscoe of Lincoln County won the grand championship and Ashlynn Schlochtermeyer of Russell County the reserve championship.

In swine conformation Hannah Baldrige of Lincoln County, Neb. was the grand champion, Brennan

Koller of Furnas, Neb. was the reserve champion and Jena Eder of Wallace County was third. Judson Baldrige of Lincoln County, Neb. in the Old Pro was first, Monty Mai second and Clay Mulligan of Scott County third. In showmanship Clay Mulligan of Scott County was first, Cheyenne Wiley of Bourbon County second and Jordon Eder of Wallace County third.
