

The Lady Mustangs next faced Atwood, who had beat them earlier in the year, and the Grant girls took advantage of the chance to avenge the loss, winning 25-16, 25-20. They served 88 percent in the first game, 23/26, and 73 percent in the second, 16/22.

Serving leaders were Rangel, Brianna White and Hope Cochran.

"We really dominated at the net," Scheopner said, "winning a lot of volleys with a spike. It was really great to see us playing so well. This win put us in the championship game against the No. 1 seed Oakley.'

Goodland lost 25-17, 25-10 to Oakley with 82 percent serving in the first game, 14/17, and 89 percent

"We did a really good job all day and in this game of setting the ball up and trying to get spikes," Scheopner said. "Not a lot of seventh grade teams can do this as well as we do.

"We got a little tired, and some of our spikes started to hit the net and go out of bounds. We also had one of our best days of serving the ball. I was really proud of how we played during the day and how much we have improved during the season. This is a very talented bunch of girls, and I look for great things in the future."
