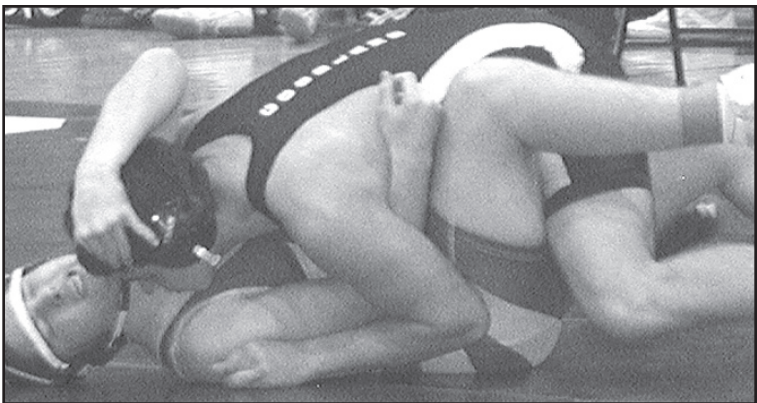
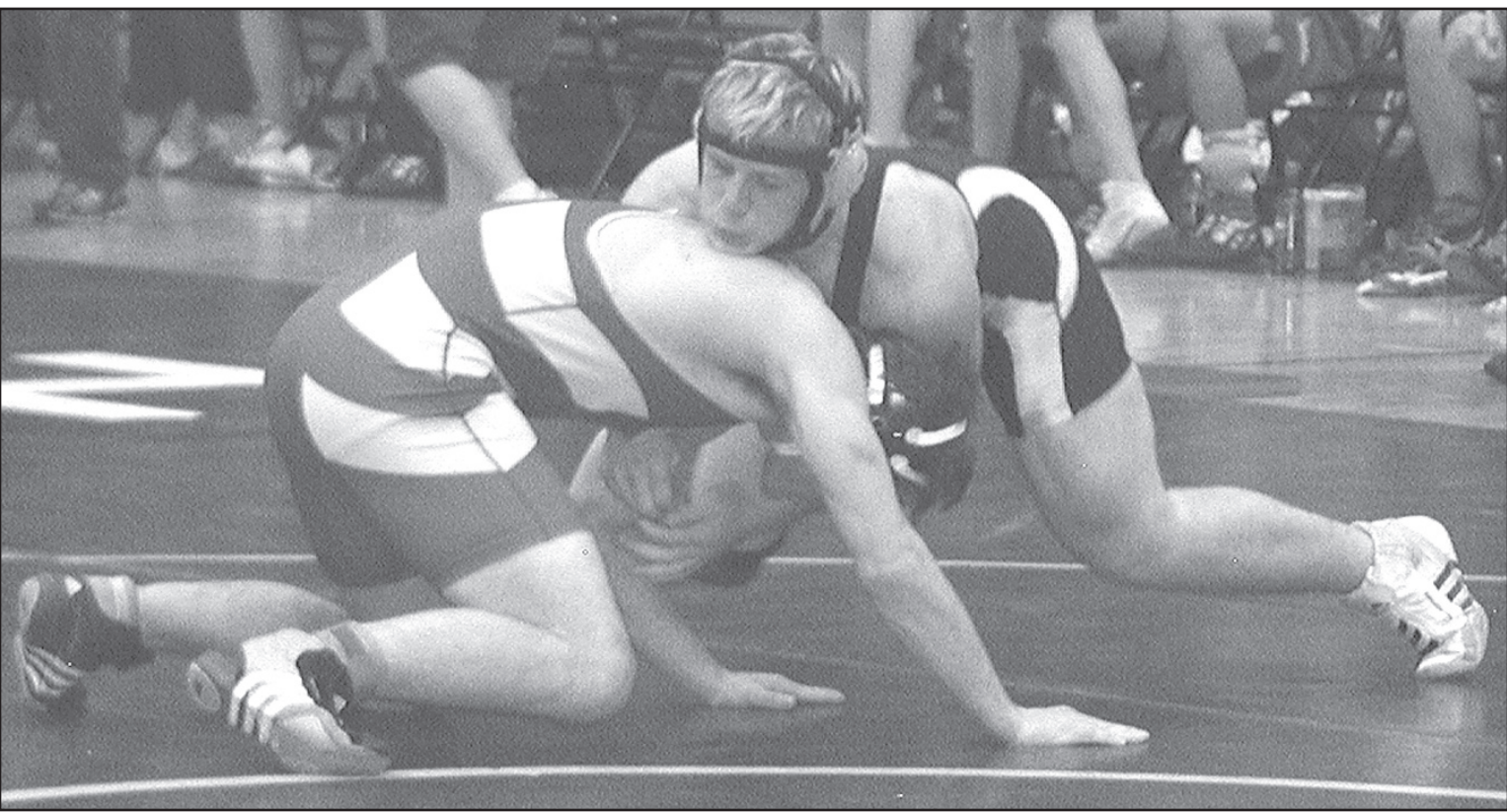
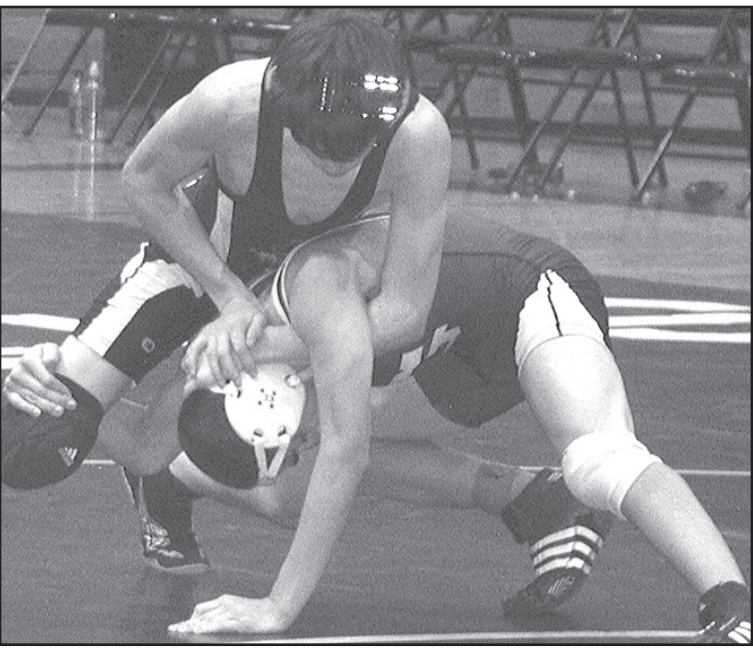
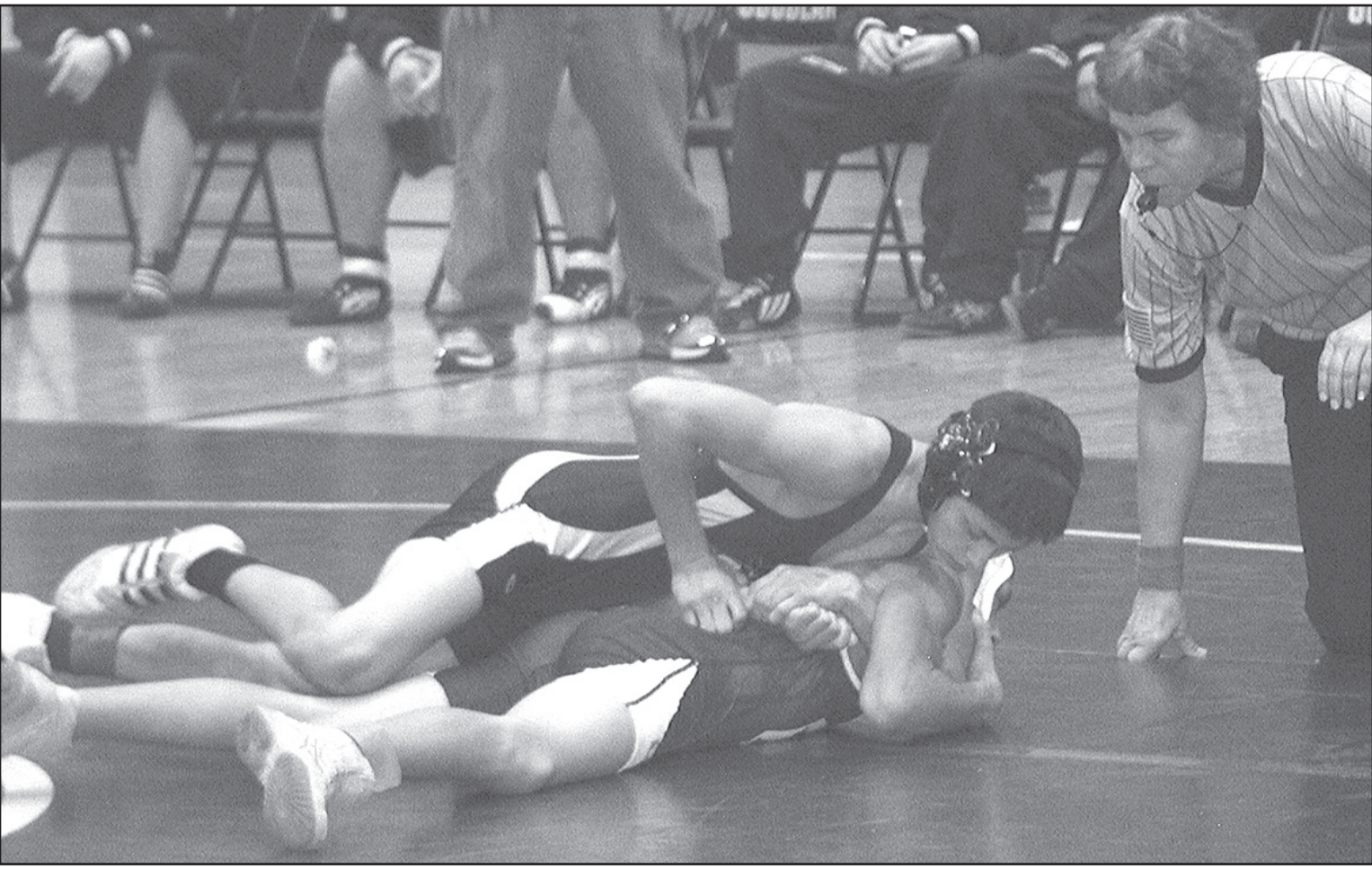
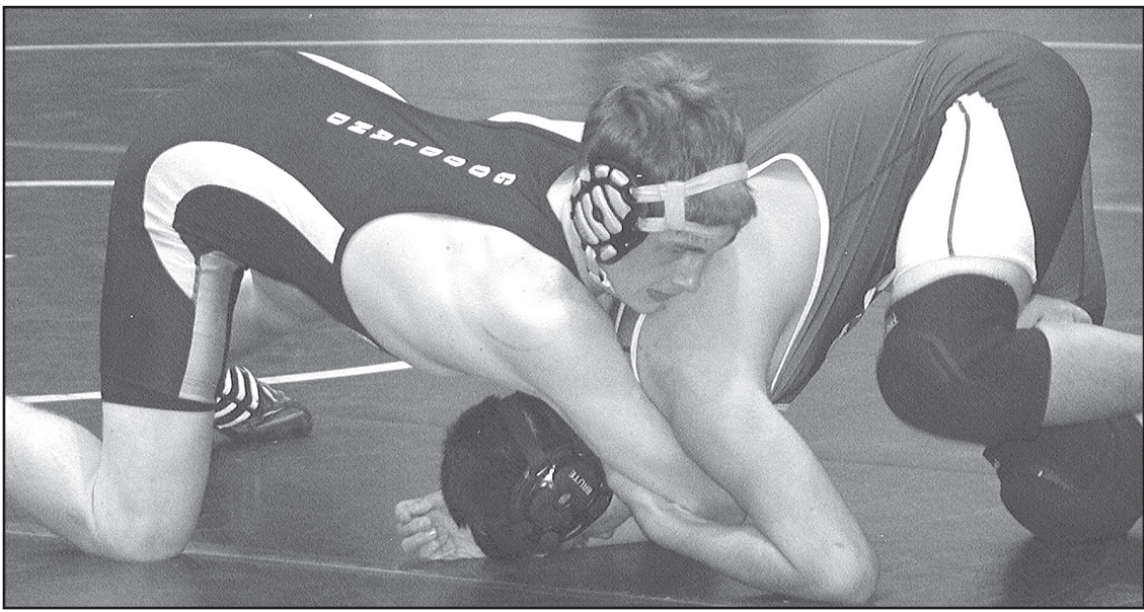


# Cowboys second at Holiday Classic
